Richard O'Brien's *The Rocky Horror Show* had humble beginnings, starting out in a small, 63-seat theatre. Yet its music, energy and wild plotline did not match the small space, and it only lasted there a month before moving to a bigger theatre. The show was a huge success, and demand grew exponentially. In 1975, once the stage show had garnered the same attention in the U.S. as in the U.K., it was adapted into a film: *The Rocky Horror Picture Show*. Today, the film version has such a large fan base that it has acquired cult status.

Most people know Rocky Horror from the movie, while the original stage show is often forgotten. As a result, when it is performed, directors often stay true to certain aspects that have been immortalized on the silver screen. Yet Queen's Musical Theatre is an organization that allows for experimentation and risk-taking, and we have taken advantage of this. By steering away from gold shorts, sequined hats and aliens, this interpretation presents an updated version of Rocky. We have made the show more accessible for a modern day crowd, whether audience members are familiar with the story or not. The stakes have been raised, the "Transylvanians" have been adapted into the outcasts of the 21st century, and the wild plotline has a more realistic feel. We have put a new twist on Rocky Horror, but all of the fun, energy and catchy tunes still stand out!
