The May 19, 2025, Meeting Minutes and May and June Financial Status Reports were reviewed and accepted with no additions or corrections. Mr. Stinson moved, seconded by Mr. Koerner to approve the May 19, 2025 meeting minutes and the Financial Status Reports for May and June. Roll call was as follows: Mr. Stinson, yes; Mr. Harrigan, yes; Mr. Koerner, yes.

Road and Maintenance Report

Mr. Harrigan - mowing and trimming – mostly roadside and cemeteries. Boggles Run, Moores Run, Woodburn, Grandview, Winn and Baptist cemetery with some weed eating. Mostly going back and forth with Grandview about once a week.

Trees - removed a couple of trees at Briarwood for some drainage issues. Down tree on Woodburn Road that was cleaned up.

Chemical vegetation control along utility poles helps mow more efficiently.

Richard repaired some of the berm work at Three Mile and Dugan by bringing some of the gravel up against the berm.

On funeral that was supported on June 5th and 6th.

We will continue with the mowing. Richard is on mowing session two. We do about 4 or 5. Just started again today on the township roads.

Old Business

Mr. Stinson – we got the trees removed from Briarwood. Still waiting on Bo (Ward) to fix the tiles. We had it scheduled and got rained out.

We also need to do a little chemical spraying alongside Three Mile and Dugan to kill some of the sod so we can pull some of the gravel back in. A couple quarter mile sections to do.

Installed road signs on Edinger and Deer Run

They completed the annexation of VanCrest and 200+ acres as of May 31st into the city. I am on the Board of the CEP and there is quite a bit of interest on that ground between the cemetery and community center. So that will be off of our fire runs.

Mr. Harrigan – when does that start?

Mr. Stinson – June 1st. We should see a difference on fire/EMS runs.

Mr. Harrigan – we replaced a couple of signs on Edinger and Deer Run in Tecumseh Woods. Heavily faded. Boggles Run keeps getting knocked over by a driver. It has happened two times this summer.

New Business

Mr. Stinson - We have an invitation to address from Sean Tullis. There is a property up on Edgewood Ave off of South and Central that has not been mowed. Sean has been working with LUC about how to properly get this on the books if they are not going to take care of it, how we can structure this if they aren't going to mow it that the township is. We have to establish rates about what we are going to charge. That has to be done next meeting. On June 25th, LUC is putting on a nuisance workshop for the whole county.

They are going to outline the process, then through BZA to be approved and added to our zoning manual exactly what our new perimeters are for that. The old ones are too vague. LUC is going to update the whole county. Next meeting we will have some ordinances that we will have to approve, then go to the next step with the zoning commission.

I know there has been calls about property up there, but we have to go through the proper steps.

New Business

Mr. Koerner moved that we approve all of the bills and authorize the disbursement of the checks. Mr. Stinson seconded the request. Roll call was as follows: Mr. Harrigan, yes; Mr. Stinson, yes.

Public Comment

Mr. Jackson – 1340 Muzzy Road, but I own property in the township. Property Center Street and Beech Street a cell phone tower owns and they are neglecting to mow the property.

Mr. Stinson – Sean has made contact and they haven't answered. He has been to the Auditors. LUC even sent a letter out.

Mr. Jackson - My understanding is by the next meeting you will have some type of ordinance, or code telling them they will be charged?

Mr. Stinson – correct.

Mr. Jackson – so we are looking at July before anything will happen.

Ms. Moore – it is already waist high. My mom used to mow it for years.

Mr. Stinson – that has been what has gotten this started with LUC.

Mr. Jackson – should we complain on the website so there is a record of that.

Mr. Harrigan – everything that we are giving you here is the latest that I know.

Mr. Moore – I see you guy do have one of these letters. It has a contact thing on there. We just have the information on where the tax information goes. (provided attached letter)

Mr. Evilsizor – who is responsible for safety matters at the cemetery? Who has been doing the spraying throughout the township, for the township? What chemicals have been sprayed and where? How deep are foundations for monument bases? How is digging monument bases? What right does the township and the cemetery have to leave the foundations bases open for excess 2 weeks as extreme safety hazard?

Mr. Harrigan – is that all your questions?

Mr. Evilsizor – you responded to previous questions are you going to respond to mine?

Mr. Harrigan – if we have an answer we will.

Mr. Stinson – I do the spraying, and I have to keep a log of all of my spraying and I keep that current. I have my commercial spraying license. Everything that I am doing is within the law.

Mr. Evilsizor – in your opinion.

Mr. Stinson – the label is the law, it is not my opinion.

Mr. Evilsizor – you said the things you are doing are within the law. That's your opinion. I am not going to argue with you.

Mr. Stinson – you have to understand the label is the law.

Mr. Evilsizor - What you stated is that you have been following it according to the law.

Mr. Stinson – I have been following application rates as is on the label.

Mr. Evilsizor - None the less, can I get a copy of that log?

Mr. Stinson – yes.

Mr. Harrigan – who is in charge of safety, that is all of us. Spraying is Blair, and how deep are foundations? We have a depth...

Mr. Stinson – usually at least 32 inches.

Mr. Evilsizor – you don't think it's proper to leave a 32 inch open hole that anyone can fall into? Anyone walking, jogging, or wildlife in excess of 2 weeks?

Mr. Stinson – Correct, the city of Urbana was supposed to pour that every day since.

Mr. Evilsizor – regardless is the city of Urbana responsible for the safety of that? Who is digging?

Mr. Stinson – Sean and I did. That is part of the delay that the city can't find anyone to dig foundations. That is why we hand mixed and poured, because the city can't find someone to. I agree, that should have been covered.

Mr. Harrigan – anything else Mr. Evilsizor?

Mr. Evilsizor – that should do it.

Mr. Harrigan – what is your address Mr. Evilsizor?

Mr. Evilsizor – you know where I live. I live in Urbana Township. I am a resident here.

Mr. Stinson moved to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Koerner seconded the request. Roll call was as follows: Mr. Stinson, yes; Mr. Harrigan, yes.
