

Repugnant E.T. Live – Privacy Policy (Including California Privacy Notice)

Effective Date: July 29, 2026

Repugnant E.T. Live is operated by **Repugnant Entertainment** (“Repugnant Entertainment,” “we,” “us,” or “our”). This Privacy Policy describes how we collect, use, share, and retain information in connection with **Repugnant E.T. Live** (the “App” or “Services”). This Privacy Policy is intended to be consistent with the **Repugnant E.T. Live Terms of Use and Community Guidelines**.

By using Repugnant E.T. Live, you acknowledge this Privacy Policy.

1) Adults Only (18+)

Repugnant E.T. Live is intended for adults. **You must be at least eighteen (18) years old** to use the Services. We do not knowingly collect personal information from anyone under 18. If you believe a person under 18 has provided personal information to us, contact us using the information in the “Contact Us” section.

2) Information We Collect

We collect information in the following categories:

A. Information you provide.

- **Account information:** email address, username, password (or information needed to authenticate through a third-party sign-in provider), and account preferences.
- **Role selection:** whether you sign up as a **Music Artist** or **Music Enthusiast** and your selected membership tier.
- **Profile information:** display name/stage name, biography, profile photo, social links, and other optional profile details.
- **Demographics:** age/date of birth (or age confirmation), and gender (including options such as “prefer not to say” or self-described fields, where offered).
- **Communications:** messages, chats, comments, support requests, and other communications you send through the Services.

B. Content you submit or upload.

- **Artist Content:** music tracks/audio files, artwork, titles, genres, descriptions, credits/metadata, and related materials submitted by Music Artists.
- **User Content:** posts, comments, images, and other content you choose to upload or share.

C. Payment and transaction information

If you make purchases, subscribe to a paid plan, purchase downloads, or send tips/donations (where enabled), we collect:

- **Transaction metadata:** payment status, transaction/reference IDs, date/time, amounts, currency, selected plan or item, and limited billing-related records.
- **Payment method details:** we **do not** intentionally collect or store full credit/debit card numbers or CVV codes on our systems when payments are handled by third-party payment processors. Payment information is generally provided directly to the payment processor.

D. Automatically collected information.

- **Usage information:** interactions with content and features (e.g., viewing activity, favorites, follows, searches, and navigation patterns) depending on what features are enabled.
- **Device and log information:** IP address, device type, operating system, language settings, timestamps, app version, and diagnostic logs (such as crash reports).

3) How We Use Information

We use information for the following purposes:

- **Provide and operate the Services,** including creating and managing Accounts, enabling streaming features, and maintaining your profile.
- **Role-based features:** enabling Music Artist tools (uploads, submissions, analytics where available) and Music Enthusiast features (discovery, engagement, support tools).

- **Eligibility and safety:** enforcing the **18+ requirement**, preventing fraud and abuse, and maintaining platform integrity and security.
- **Moderation and enforcement:** reviewing reports, responding to complaints (including copyright claims), and enforcing the Terms of Use and Community Guidelines.
- **Transactions:** processing subscriptions, purchases, tips/donations, download entitlements, confirmations/receipts, and customer support related to payments.
- **Communications:** sending service-related messages (e.g., security notices, transactional notices, feature updates) and responding to support requests.
- **Improve the Services:** troubleshooting, quality assurance, and understanding usage patterns to improve user experience (including analytics where enabled).
- **Legal compliance:** complying with applicable laws, regulations, and lawful requests.

4) What Information Is Public

Because Repugnant E.T. Live includes public discovery features, some information may be visible to other users and/or the public depending on your role, settings, and how content is distributed within the Services.

A. Music Artist public information (typical examples)

- Music Artist profile display name/stage name
- Profile photo, bio, social links (if provided)
- Published Artist Content (such as track titles, artwork, and playable tracks)
- Public posts or comments made by the Music Artist (if those features are enabled)

B. Music Enthusiast public information (typical examples)

- Username/display name (as shown in the Services)
- Comments, reactions, and messages where you choose to share them (if enabled)

C. Information that is not intended to be public.

We do not intend to make the following public by default:

- email address
- full date of birth (if collected)
- payment details
- private support communications (except as needed for support and legal compliance)

Important: If you choose to include personal information in your profile, posts, comments, or messages, you are making that information available in the manner you share it.

5) How We Share Information

We may share information in the following circumstances:

A. Service providers (generic)

We share information with **third-party service providers** that help us operate Repugnant E.T. Live, such as providers for:

- cloud hosting, content delivery, and file storage
- authentication and account management
- customer support tools
- analytics and performance monitoring (if enabled)
- security and fraud prevention

These providers are permitted to process information only to perform services for us and are expected to protect it consistent with applicable obligations.

B. Payment processors

When you pay for subscriptions, purchases, downloads, or tips/donations, payment processing is handled by **third-party payment processors**. We share necessary transaction information to process payments, prevent fraud, and provide receipts/entitlements. The payment processor's privacy practices apply to information they process.

C. Legal and safety disclosures

We may disclose information if we believe it is reasonably necessary to:

- comply with law, regulation, subpoena, court order, or lawful government request.
- protect the rights, property, and safety of Repugnant Entertainment, our users, or others.
- investigate and enforce the Terms of Use and Community Guidelines
- detect, prevent, or address fraud or security issues.

D. Business transfers

If Repugnant Entertainment is involved in a merger, acquisition, financing, reorganization, bankruptcy, or sale of assets, information may be transferred as part of that transaction, consistent with applicable law.

6) Payments, Tips/Donations, and Processing Fees

Repugnant E.T. Live may offer paid Plans, purchases/downloads, and optional artist support features such as tips/donations.

Tips/Donations Processing Fee

Where tips and/or donations are enabled, you may be charged a **five percent (5%) processing fee** on the tip/donation amount to help cover payment processing and operational costs. **Any applicable fee will be disclosed at or before checkout.**

What we store

We generally store only limited payment-related information needed to manage your transaction and account, such as:

- transaction/reference IDs
- amount, currency, and status
- plan type or item purchased
- Timestamps

We do not intend to store full payment card details on our servers when a third-party payment processor is used.

7) Data Retention

We retain information for as long as reasonably necessary to provide the Services and for legitimate business purposes, such as:

- maintaining Accounts and providing access to content
- complying with legal and accounting requirements
- resolving disputes and enforcing agreements
- preventing fraud and abuse

Account deletion and public content

If you delete your Account, we may remove or de-identify certain information. However, we may retain certain records as required or permitted by law and as described in the Terms of Use. If you are a Music Artist, removal of publicly visible Artist Content may not be immediate and may depend on technical, contractual, operational, or legal requirements.

8) Security

We use reasonable administrative, technical, and organizational measures designed to protect information from unauthorized access, loss, misuse, or alteration. However, no system can be guaranteed to be 100% secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.

9) Your Rights and Choices

Depending on your location and applicable law, you may have rights regarding your personal information, such as the right to access, correct, or delete certain information.

Common choices and controls

- **Update profile information** through your Account settings (where available).
- **Change gender selection** or choose “prefer not to say” (where available).
- **Opt out of marketing communications** by using the unsubscribe link (if marketing emails are sent).
- **Request account deletion** through in-app settings (if available) or by contacting us.

10) Analytics and Advertising (If enabled)

Repugnant E.T. Live may use analytics tools to understand performance and improve the Services. Repugnant E.T. Live may also display advertising as part of certain Plans or experiences.

If we enable analytics or advertising that involves additional data collection or sharing (including activities that may be considered **“sharing” under California privacy law**, such as cross-context behavioral advertising), we will update this Privacy Policy as appropriate and provide required disclosures and opt-out choices.

11) Do Not Sell or Share My Personal Information (California)

Repugnant E.T. Live does not sell personal information for money. If Repugnant E.T. Live enables certain advertising or analytics features that may be considered **“sharing” under California law**, you will be able to opt out through a **“Manage Privacy Choices”** setting (where available).

12) Changes to This Privacy Policy

We may update this Privacy Policy from time to time. We will post the updated version with a new Effective Date. If changes are material, we may provide additional notice (for example, within the App or by email). Your continued use of Repugnant E.T. California Privacy Notice (CCPA/CPRA)

This section applies only to individuals who are California residents and supplements the Privacy Policy above. For purposes of this section, “personal information” has the meaning given in the California Consumer Privacy Act as amended by the California Privacy Rights Act (“CCPA/CPRA”).

A) Categories of Personal Information Collected

In the last 12 months, Repugnant E.T. Live may have collected the following categories of personal information:

- **Identifiers:** name or username, email address, account identifiers, IP address, and other similar identifiers.
- **Customer records information:** account profile information you provide (e.g., stage name, bio, links).
- **Commercial information:** records of subscriptions, purchases, downloads, tips/donations, and transaction metadata (e.g., transaction IDs, amounts, status).
- **Internet or other electronic network activity:** interactions with the Services such as viewing activity, searches, favorites, follows, and engagement actions (depending on what features are enabled).
- **Audio/visual and user-generated content:** uploaded audio tracks, artwork, images, posts, comments, messages, and other content you choose to submit.
- **Geolocation data (approximate):** location derived from IP address (approximate only).
- **Sensitive personal information (limited):** age/date of birth and gender (where provided). We use this information for limited purposes such as eligibility, account settings, and service operations.

B) Sources of Personal Information

We collect personal information from:

- You directly (when you create an account, complete a profile, upload content, or contact support)
- Automatically from your device/browser when you use the Services.

- Service providers (e.g., authentication providers, hosting providers, payment processors) as necessary to provide the Services.

C) Purposes for Collection and Use

We collect and use personal information for:

- Operating and maintaining repugnantentertainment.com & Repugnant E.T. Live
- Providing role-based features to Music Artists and Music Enthusiasts
- Processing transactions and providing entitlements/receipts
- Security, fraud prevention, and enforcing our Terms/Guidelines
- Debugging and service improvement
- Legal compliance

D) Disclosures of Personal Information

In the last 12 months, Repugnant E.T. Live may have disclosed personal information for business purposes to:

- **Service providers** (cloud hosting, storage, authentication, analytics/performance monitoring if enabled, customer support tools)
- **Payment processors** to complete transactions
- **Legal authorities** or other parties where required by law or to protect rights and safety.

E) “Sale” or “Sharing” of Personal Information

- **We do not sell personal information** in exchange for money.
- We also do not knowingly “sell” or “share” personal information of individuals under 18 (and Repugnant E.T. Live is 18+ only).
- If Repugnant E.T. Live enables advertising or analytics features that may be considered “sharing” under California law (such as cross-context behavioral advertising), we will update this Privacy Policy and provide required opt-out rights and instructions.

F) Your California Privacy Rights

Subject to certain legal exceptions, you may have the right to:

- Know what personal information we collected, used, disclosed, and (if applicable) sold/shared.
- Access a copy of your personal information.
- Delete personal information we collected from you.
- Correct inaccurate personal information.
- Opt out of the sale or sharing of personal information (if applicable)
- Limit the use and disclosure of sensitive personal information (where applicable)
- Non-discrimination for exercising your rights.
