Organization – Is your project presented in some organized manner? Does your video begin and end with information to help focus the viewer's attention.	5 - Difficult to follow. Does not inform; does not stay focused on the topic. No research seems included</p>	<p>20 - Project has problems staying focused on topic. Information is incoherent at times. The video shows a shallow depth of knowledge on the topic. Project is researched to a fair degree. Only one source was used and it was questionably used or cited.</p>	<p>30 - Video is focused on an informative topic. Video makes understanding the topic fairly accessible and easy. Video demonstrates a depth of knowledge on the topic. Project is well researched. Only one source semi-appropriately used.</p>	<p>50 - Video is laser focused on the topic. Some pictures or video clips may be out of focus or “shaky”. Some screens do not change angles/colors/ words very frequently.</p>	<p>15 - Good use of graphics and/or other design elements.
