Membership Application

The Navy League of the United States was established in 1902 to support the Sea Services: Navy Marine Corps, Coast Guard, Military Sealift Command and the Merchant Marine. Local Councils were established to provide a means to support the Sea Services at the local level. The Richmond, Virginia Council was established in 1958. Anyone can join. Prior military service is not a membership requirement and active-duty service members are eligible to join.

National Navy League membership includes: Subscription to *Seapower* magazine, opportunities to support those currently serving, invitations to local events and ship commissionings, ability to join national committees to make policy changes and impact legislation, member-only discounts with more than 20 companies and relevant and timely news and information.

The Richmond Council Navy League adopts ships and shore commands, rewards and honors enlisted personnel, hosts dinners and celebrations with speakers for Council members and Sea Service personnel, supports American Division Sea Cadets and Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps in nine Richmond area high schools, publishes the Lucky Bug monthly newsletter, hosts an Annual Golf Fund Raiser Event and mails care packages to deployed sea service members.
