

Things to Celebrate!

Millersville Social Work Interns accomplish

much!: We were delighted to have Rebecca Mohr and Holly Triverelli complete 3-month social work practicums at We Rise this summer. They worked with We Rise' team member Deb Miller on Church Assessments, identified BIPOC mental health educational resources for Churches, and helped develop the winter webinar series. When asked if they'd recommend interning at We Rise to others, Rebecca said "Yes. I would recommend We Rise for their close-knit family type feel, their kindness and generosity working with the interns and allowing us to experience the field of social work." Holly added "Through trauma webinars, church assessments, and "Streetlights" (book), I have gained a much deeper understanding and passion for mental health and trauma throughout this internship. I did not expect to learn nearly as much as I did and I have gained confidence as a social worker while working as an intern with We Rise."

Churches Complete "Church Assessments"

This spring through fall 2022 churches of various sizes and denominations are taking part in Church Assessment congregational surveys and consultations with the We Rise team. Reviewing the responses from the survey of their entire congregation, We Rise supports each church as they identify ways to increase congregational education on mental health & addictions, reduce stigma in their church, and develop strategies for increasing support and assistance within their church for people experiencing mental illnesses or addictions.



Collaboration established with Campbell University - Graduate Program in Public Health: This fall, We Rise is pleased to welcome our first 5 Masters of Public Health students from Campbell University, a Christian University in Buies Creek, NC, for 60-hour per semester practicums with We Rise. We look forward to this new partnership!

CHURCHES CARE - IN PHILADELPHIA

Churches Care Program educates church leaders in Philadelphia

In Spring 2022 we were honored to bring the Churches Care Program live trainings to Philadelphia, in partnership with the Eastern University Seminary. We appreciated spending two Saturdays providing education and discussion with Philadelphia church leaders, on the topics of mental illnesses, addictions, and ways churches can reduce stigma and more effectively support people who are experiencing these needs.

We were excited to have a diverse group of church leaders participate in Philly, including a large percentage of black and Latina female church and lay leaders. We were inspired by the group's passion and insight on the topics, and our team was truly impacted by our time spent with them. They blessed us! It was an opportunity both to teach and learn. One thing we discovered during our interactions with the Philly church leaders is that the percentage of information on Black, Latino, Asian and Indigenous (BIPOC) content in our Churches Care trainings and resources needed to be expanded. We have worked hard this summer 2022 to strengthen that content in the curriculum and are having it reviewed and evaluated by BIPOC Churches Care participants.
