Dear Mr. Chambers:

On August 6, 2015, the Department of Justice received an undated note from you handwritten on a copy of my June 5, 2015 letter sent to you in response to previous correspondence with our office. Included with your note were 23 pages containing allegations similar to your prior submittal.

Thank you for writing again to the Department of Justice (DOJ). However, while I can appreciate your reiterated concerns, DOJ remains unable to assist you with this matter. As I explained previously, DOJ may only exercise jurisdiction in criminal matters and issues of statewide concern.

Once again, I encourage you to contact your local police department if you should need immediate assistance with any crimes being committed against you, or to discuss any alleged crimes where you feel you are a victim, as they have the authority to investigate such allegations.

As I explained in my previous letter, there are also some alternative resources available to you, and you may wish to contact them. Again, those alternatives would include reporting your concerns to the Housing Authority of the city of Milwaukee (HACM) or applying to obtain a harassment restraining order (Milwaukee County Courthouse, Room 711).
