- and the Shuhada Maukab, honoring sacrifice, courage, and steadfastness.

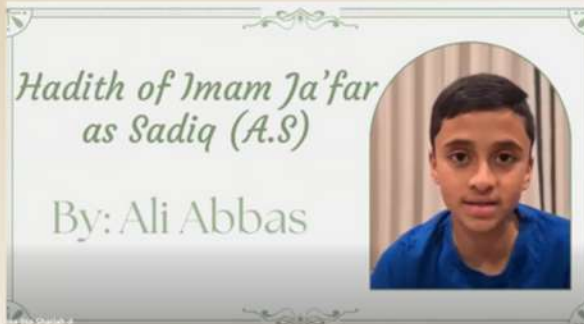
The event set a powerful tone for the academic year, motivating students towards a productive and spiritually uplifting academic journey ahead.

MIJS Online commemorated Ayyam-e-Fatimiyya with a special event that allowed students to reflect deeply on the life, teachings, and legacy of Lady Fatima Zahra (S). The event was designed with different segments, each highlighting a unique aspect of her luminous personality and timeless guidance.

The event featured a segment "Through the Eyes of Innocence," where our little stars expressed their love through artworks inspired by the Lady of Light (S). This was followed by the segment "Living the Words of Lady Fatima (S)," that encouraged students to reflect on the practical implementation of her sayings in their daily lives.

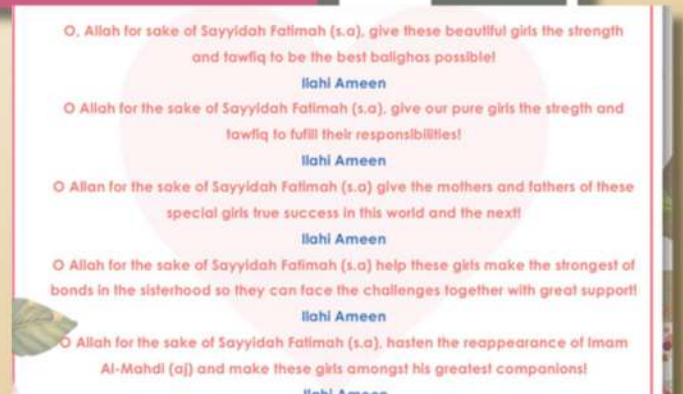
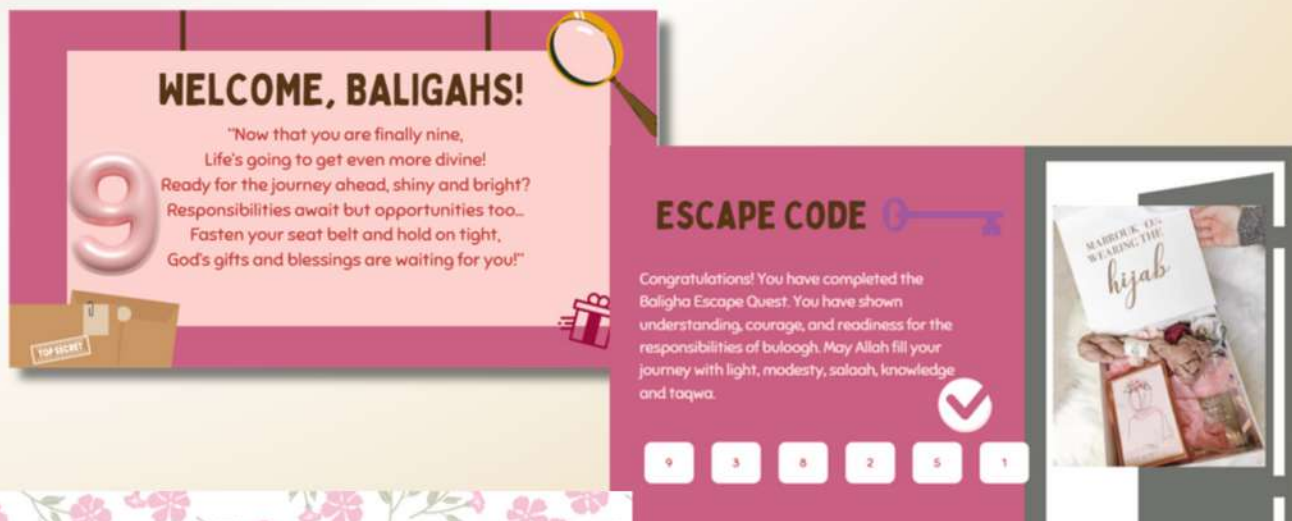
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JASHAN E BULOUGH FOR GIRLS 20TH DEC 2025

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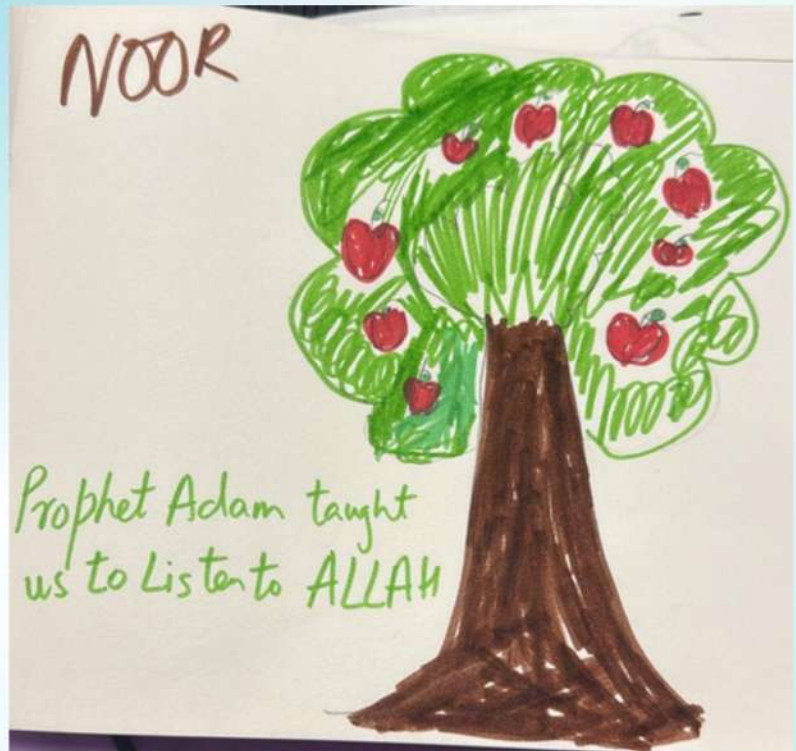

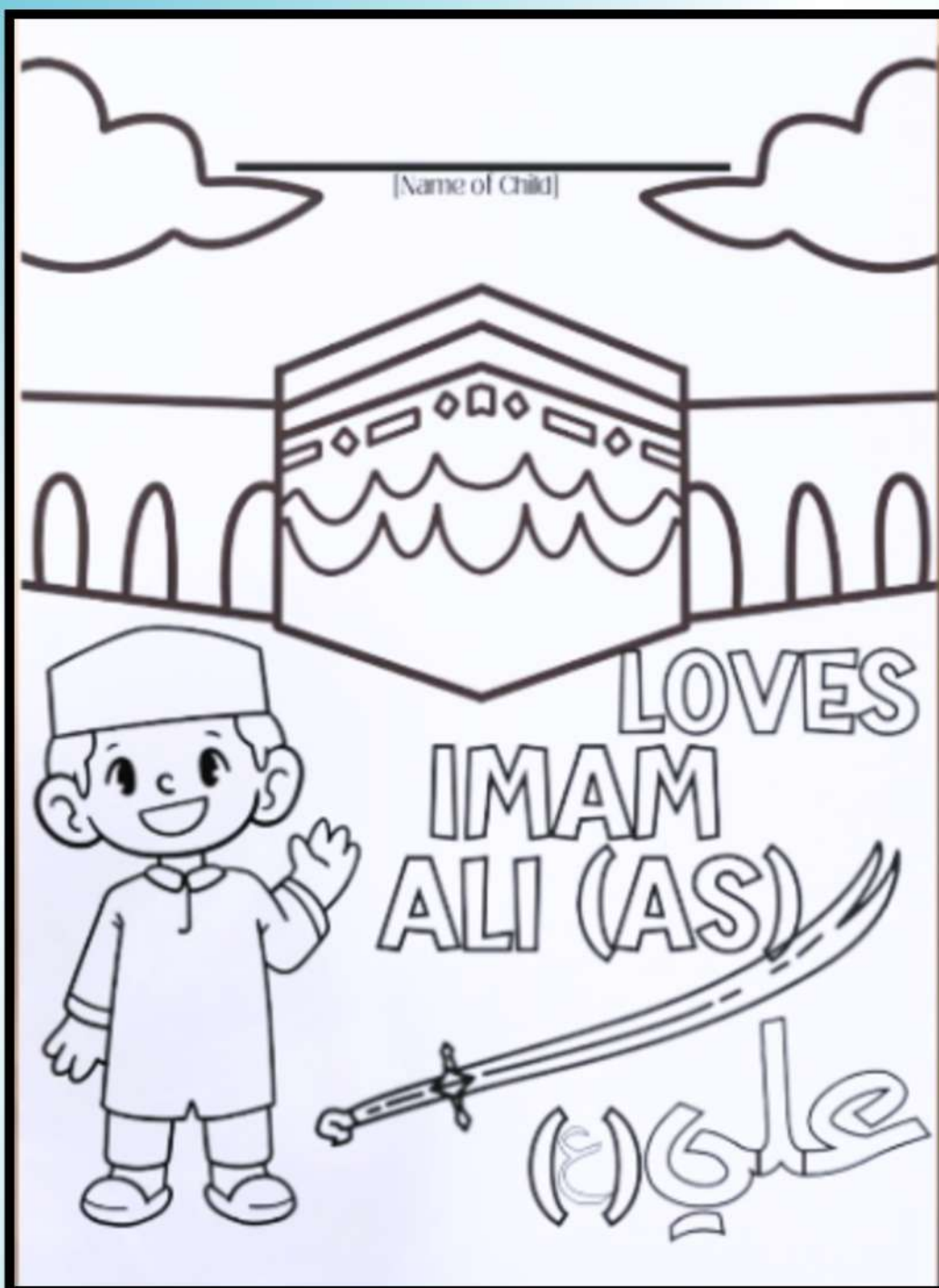

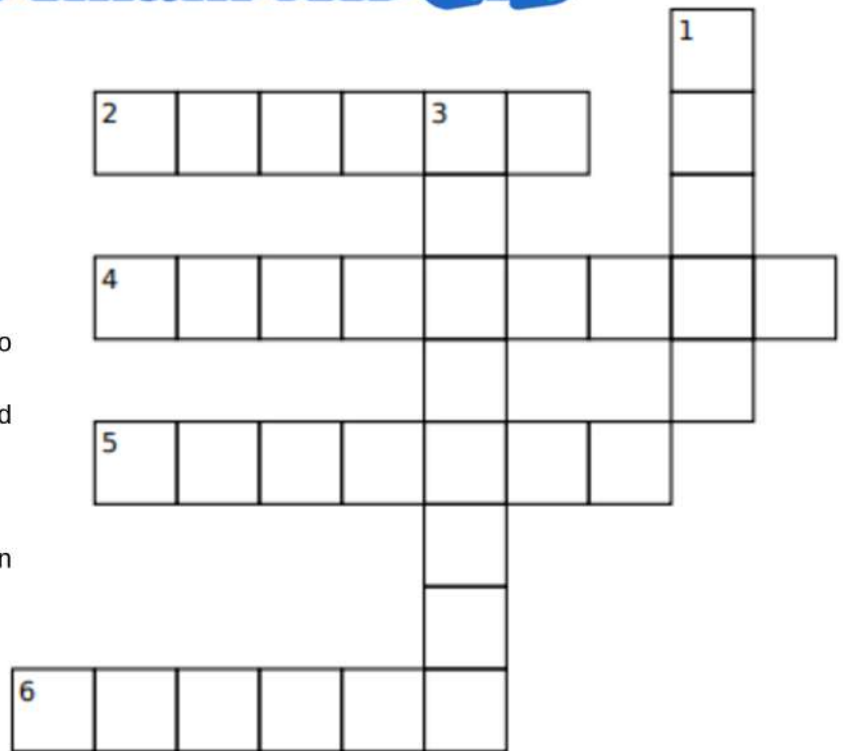
