

he was arrested, beaten, imprisoned and executed. Now here is the cool Easter part – in Matthew 28:2 we read There was a violent earthquake, for an angel of the Lord came down from heaven and, going to the tomb, rolled back the stone and sat on it. And in Acts 16:26 Suddenly there was such a violent earthquake that the foundations of the prison were shaken. At once all the prison doors flew open, and everyone's chains came loose. In both these cases we see God shaking open these prisons that held Jesus, Paul, and Silas. Now please understand - I am not saying that violent earthquakes that we see on the TV news that cause massive destruction, pain, suffering, and death are acts of God. The things we see here in scripture were powerful transformative awesome focused moments of God right there in those places – lives were saved, made whole, blest. Jesus was free of his tomb! Paul and Silas were free of their prison thanks to God's power and love! And from that other lives were saved, changed, blest, souls fixed for heaven - just read on! And so can you be - we are part of that amazing story too!

So what I want to ask you today – what are your prisons that hold you? – bitterness, anger, addictions, resentments, past pains, disappointments, hopelessness, anxiety, fear? – we all have things that seek to chain us, imprison us – the point of Easter is that nothing in Christ can hold us back! The message of Easter – the chains are broken, the door is open, the tomb is open, the grave cannot hold you, the prison cannot hold your spirit anymore! You are free! Get up! Rise! He is Risen, because what – because of Him – so are you! Happy Easter! Amen.


