July 8, 2025 Single Board Meeting Minutes

Attendees: Andrew Harvala, Linda Olson, Gene Stoekel, Michele Elifrits, Scott Liestman, Bob Laskowski.

Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm by Linda Olson.

Minutes of June 10, 2025 meeting were approved electronically.

Prayer and Scripture: Shared by Linda, Hebrews 3:13 Encourage one another daily! Discussion was held on if any of the board is feeling burnt out? The feeling was that none of the board members present where feeling burnt out. But there was encouragement for everyone to step forward and volunteer for something no matter how small. The other thing of frustration is communication. When called, texted, or emailed, please respond.

Financial Reports: Michele reported that we are about \$10,000 down from last year at this time, of which \$3000 is less giving and \$7000 is increased expenses. Pastor Kevin has sent out a letter to the congregation to please increase giving as this could become serious soon. Investments: Scott reported that the accounts are all up at this time and it was decided to let everything continue to compound for a while. Some CD interest will come due in October that will continue to fund the Parking Lot account.

SPRC Report: Gene reported that they are interviewing 5 applicants out of 19 applications. They feel they have some very strong applicants and hope to have someone hired to replace Jenna by August 1st so they can train with Jenna for 2 weeks before she is done on August 15th.

Trustee Report: Andrew shared that the new water heater is now installed and that Brian McMullen is finishing up the electrical hook up. Thank you Brian! \$10,000 was taken from the endowment account to pay for the new water heater. The motion to take the \$10,000 was done electronically a couple weeks ago as it could not wait until the board meeting. We have been blessed by good markets to allow us to take some moneys.

New Business: Linda has challenged all the board members to start a small weekly groups. And it doesn't have to be the board members, anyone can start a small group. There is a resource available through "Right Now Media" that will help guide you in the topics and process to get started. The most successful churches have thriving small groups.

Adjournment: Motion by Gene, 2nd by Linda. Passed.
