### FROM THE PASTOR

Greeting and blessings to you my sisters and brothers! Happy and blessed New Year to you and your family!

As I sit here and write this newsletter it is still 2020, the celebration of Christ's birth is still a couple of weeks away. I am pondering the state of the world as we prepare to receive the Christ child and to welcome in a new year. I want to be honest with you the state of my heart. It is heavy. You look at social media and the news you see lots of darkness – you see people fostering hate and encouraging violence/revenge; you see increasing talk of an impending civil war; you see all kinds of pain as a result of the coronavirus; and so on. I saw a Facebook post where in St Anthony, MN people received an anonymous letter decrying people who have Christmas lights on their homes as a sign of systemic bias and prejudice! There is a lot of darkness in people's hearts right now.

Despite the darkness there are signs of hope – in the community of Brainerd there were 900 people who paid for the person behind them in the drive through at Dairy Queen. Isn't that great? Being light in the midst of dark times! My friends the call of Christmas, the call of Christ's birth, and the call to the church in the new year is to be the light. The church is at its best in times of darkness as history bears witness. As I think about our own congregational future, we need to return to what it really means to be the church. In the book of Acts we see very clearly the church in its infancy, a vision movement of the Holy Spirit ready to share the Good News of Christ with the world. What does this mean? It means that we have to get back to basics: primacy of Christ in our lives; understanding of God's Word as Truth – and not to be afraid to stand for it; the church's mission is to make disciples of all nations; to take our eternal destiny seriously; to get rid of things that causes people to stumble in their faith; to worship the Lord with all our hearts, to love our neighbor, and to love the person God created us to be.

We are now providing prefilled communion cups and wafers to anyone who would like to participate in at-home communion.


