

Sunday School

Kids will get to participate in or watch some fun experiments that remind them of some of the amazing miracles Jesus did. These miracles show us how awesome God is and why Jesus is our Savior. Jesus Walks On Water – When Jesus miraculously walked on water, he showed us that if we have faith like Peter did, God can use us to do miracles just like Jesus was able to do. We just have to keep our eyes on Jesus and not be distracted by the waves. Kids will be reminded of Peter and Jesus' miraculous walk on water as they watch some sinking eggs learn to float. Matthew 14:22-33

Jesus Heals a Blind Man – When Jesus passed by this blind man on the side of the road it changed his life. This simple experiment will show something surprising happen to a coke can just by having someone's hand pass by it. Kids will learn that Jesus wants to and can make our life amazing, we just have to ask him to like the blind man did. Luke 18:35-43

Jesus Rises From the Dead – The surprising rising water in this experiment will remind kids of how Jesus miraculously rose from the dead on Easter Sunday. Kids will be given an opportunity to ask Jesus to be their Savior, now that they know how amazing Jesus is and how much he loves them. Luke 24:1-12, 36 -53

QUILTERS YEAR IN REVIEW

The Freshwaters' Quilting group has had a year of trying new things. With the COVID pandemic, we took many precautions to keep people safe, and with vaccinations, we could meet on Tuesdays. We want to thank all those who have donated cotton quilting fabric and supplies throughout the year. It is greatly appreciated. As you can see, we do keep busy.

*We donated a quilt to the Princeton High School Senior class for their senior party.

*Our first event was in July when Abby Lingle was kind enough to invite us to sell our quilts and creations at her outdoor Art Fair in Milaca, where we raised & donated \$2000 toward UMW missions such as Feed My Starving Children.

*We have quilts set aside for Pastor Kevin to give to homeless people or anyone in need.

*Wheelchair and walker bags and clothing covers were made and donated to Princeton ELIM.



*The last quilt that Juanita Laskowski worked on was finished and given to Jim.

*We sent several quilts and some fabric to the Navajo people in the West, as they desperately needed blankets and fabric to make blankets.


*We decided to have our 1st Freshwaters' Sidewalk Sale (including gift baskets, gift items, crafts, & baked goods) in early October, including coffee and warm rolls made by Sue Lingle. We raised \$2000, which was donated directly to the church fund.

*We made 15 baptism quilts this year, and over 200 tiny pocket prayer quilts were made and given out to remind us of God's love & presence during difficult times.

*It took us over a year to make the 23 patriotic quilts gifted to our veterans in November, honoring them and their families.

*In late December, we donated about 40 quilts to the people who experienced the devastating tornadoes in the south. Our quilters continue to collaborate with another quilt group in the area that finds a way to get supplies and quilts to people in need. (It's the same group that drove the quilts to the Navajo people.)

*We continue to sell our quilts and gift items in the "Gift Shop" downstairs and in the Fellowship Hall, which has brought in more donations.

Ahead of the meeting the agenda had been approved, as had the minutes from the December 14, 2021 board meeting (electronically).

The meeting opened with prayer by Pastor Kevin.

Next, Susan Kettelhodt gave a Financial Report. On its year-end income statement, Freshwaters ended 2021 on a positive note, and though giving was slightly down from last year, folks are continuing to give regularly.

Andrew Harvala provided the Trustee Report, which included approval on a new door for the bell tower, and solicitation for bids for maintenance of and improvements to the fellowship hall. Additionally, there is new signage up on the corners.

Darren Wesloh gave a report for the SPRC, indicating the SPRC would be soon meeting with Freshwaters' employees to complete their reviews.

Pastor Kevin spoke next regarding Freshwaters' children's ministry. He'd recently met with Angela Harvala, Bethany Moos, Jenna Jenson, and Cayla Lusche to map out Sunday School for the remainder of the season They will be using the SCIENCE WITH JESUS curriculum on Sundays, as well as organizing fun activities/events for the kids, such as bowling, pizza parties, sledding, lock-ins, etc. The youth group will meet at Kevin's house on Sunday evenings from 6:00-7:00.

Notifications about Sunday School and youth programs will be communicated out on a weekly basis through email and Facebook.

In addition to the bible study hosted by Dick Gist in the library, another small group, hosted by Andrew, will resume in March.

Freshwaters is in need of volunteers to help organize and schedule: 1) ushers & greeters; 2) fellowship/coffee hour.

In the spring, the single board plans to meet for a day of prayer, fellowship, and discernment regarding goals for 2022.

The next single board meeting will be February 8th.
