

#### CHILDREN'S MINISTRY UPDATE

On Sunday, December 12, 2021, Cori Wallace informed me that she intends to step down as our Coordinator of Children's Ministry as of January 1, 2022.

Her reason is that she might more fully focus on her family as it is going through major transitions. Our conversation was filled with love, grace, honesty, openness, compassion, and understanding. I shared with her that our congregation loves her and her family. We will walk with them as they journey together through this unique time in their lives. I shared with her that Freshwaters Church will be a safe place for them as they prayerfully walk day by day into their future.

We give thanks to Cori for her passion, creativity, leadership, and hard work for the children of our congregation. Her love for the children is evident! She has done incredible things for our church, such as renovating the lower level, creating "Christmas in July," and working with other congregations in a collaborative VBS.

We have seen her volunteer on the praise team, worship committee and helping pitch in where she can. She and her family have blessed us!

In the interim, I will be working with Cayla Lusche and other volunteers to ensure an ongoing children's and youth ministry. Announcements as to the schedule for January will be coming out in the next week or two for our families. The SPRC and the Single Board will be in prayer as we look into the future regarding the needs of this critically important ministry of our congregation. Please be in prayer for this ministry!

On January 16, 2021 – Sunday School will reconvene --- Pastor Kevin and Cayla Lusche will be the primary persons leading it until we hire someone else, or a volunteer oversees it.

I feel continuity and stability of the program are of primary importance.

We will be using an exciting curriculum that will take us from January through February. We will be doing science experiments and learning about God. While we use this curriculum, we will be planning out the remainder of the 2022 year with a group of parent volunteers.

The Sunday School schedule will be like this:

 8:30–9:15 AM – prep and set up for Sunday School, technology check and set up, making sure that the craft area is ready – one for the little children and one for the older children.

Immediately after worship:

- 10:30–10:45 AM snack and refreshment time downstairs so that we can have the kids down in the lower level ready to go. We will need water, lemonade, cookies, and salty snacks already set up – ready to go when the children arrive. Music will be playing in the background.
- 10:45–11:00 AM music learning, Bible verse memorization/discussion prep for future worship participation – we would like to see if we can get the kids to sing one or two songs each month (we will need help with either guitar, piano, writing out the words on paper for the kids to see)
- 1:00am-11:15am lesson time/craft (the 10:45-11:15 will merge together, ebb and flow week to week)
- 0 11:15 AM-11:30 AM craft, clean up, prayer, ending song

We will need adult volunteers to help with set up, clean up, and general help – taking children for a bathroom break if needed, etc. We need a small team of adults to help plan out the curriculum and fun activities that we can take our children/youth out together, such as sliding, bowling, pizza party, and maybe even a lock-in. December 14, 2021

Linda Olson called the meeting to order at 7:05 pm. Present were Scott Liestman, Kevin Fox, Andrew Harvala, Susan Kettelhodt, Linda Olson, David Halverson, Darren Wesloh and Phil Lingle.

Kevin began with a Scripture reading.

Susan reviewed the financial report. Giving has increased this fall and we have a positive balance with net income at \$3999. The church received a gift of stock to be applied to the general fund. A motion was made and passed to cash out that stock and apply it to the general fund. A motion was made and passed to add Scott Liestman's name on the Edward Jones and Growth Funds accounts. Andrew and Susan will remain listed.

Andrew reported the Trustees' next project will be replacing the doors on the bell tower. Funds are available in the Trustee account.

Darren and Kevin discussed the upcoming staffing changes. Cori Wallace has resigned the Youth Director position as of Jan.1, 2022. Kevin will work with Cayla Lusche and other volunteers to keep the program going through spring, with the job getting posted next summer to start next fall. Sawyer intends to reduce his time coordinating the music and worship programs next year with the intention of resigning the post at the end of 2022.

A motion was made and passed to give Sawyer and Bethany a yearend bonus for the dedicated work for our church.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:02.


