Minutes from Aug 2, 2022 board meeting were approved electronically

Financial Report-Susan Kettelhodt -

- Our checking account has dropped by \$6000 from last month causing some concern. Despite our shortfall, all bills are current. Our hope is that with the summer over, our giving will pick up this fall. Everyone pray for an answer to our giving shortfall.
- There was a bill for \$528.46 for oven repair that was paid from general budget. We will transfer funds from the trustee account to cover that expense.
- Our overall income remains down about \$17000 from last year.
- Scott reported that our investment accounts continue to go down with the markets. They will be fine in the long term.

From last meeting: Sue has received something by mail in regards to an "Employee Retention Credit". She will look into it but is thinking it to not be worth it for us? This item was not discussed at this meeting.

Trustee Report- Andrew Harvala

- Our best option for fixing the 20 year old HVAC unit is to replace it with two units. One for the sanctuary and one for the fellowship hall. The estimated cost will be about \$60,000. Since we are nearly through the cooling season and we would not be able to get it done quickly, we will wait until March/April of 2023 to get this done. We have about half the money set aside for this project and are looking for ideas on how to fund the rest?
- Trustees decided to continue with our current insurer Brotherhood Mutual as they took good care of us on our existing claims. Rates have increased about 30% over last year, which seems consistent with all insurers.

Mary Miller is now in charge of Elim Oasis.

SPRC Report- Darren Wesloh

- SPRC will be reviewing feed back review forms on Pastor Kevin with District Sup Fred Vanderwerf
- It was approved to pay Jenna for 3 more hours per week to allow for Sunday School prep.

Sawyer Carey is resigning end of the year. Worship team is working on this transition NEXT MEETING TO BE ON Oct 11 at 7pm.




