Scripture Reference - Hebrews 13:2 Thinking of famous battles, I have been reflecting a lot on the Battle of Leuthen, was fought on December 5, 1757 during Seven Years War. The Seven Years War the first real "world war" as it was fought Europe, India, the Caribbean, and in Nor America. To us in the United States this conflict was known as the "French and Indian War." The Battle of Leuthen was between the Prussian army under Frederick the Great and the Austrian army. The Prussians were outnumbered at least two to one, and it was a hard fought battle ending with a Prussian victory. In the aftermath of the battle a lone Prussian soldier began to sing the hymn Nun Danket Alle Gott (Now Thank We All Our God). Legend has it that as he began to sing, other soldiers joined him until the whole army was singing praise to God. They were not singing to God because they won the battle, but because they survived it. For me it is a truly moving story!

We as a nation, congregation and I suspect many of you have been through many battles. And I imagine that at the end of the day, we are just glad to have survived – we are thankful that the battle has past, and we have made it to another day. The Pilgrims fought the battle against the elements; and they were thankful to God and to the native people for their help that they lived through another season. Thanksgiving is more than just food and football -it is about thanking God for his provision, for caring for us through times of triumph and times of trial! When we reframe things along these lines; it helps us to see life in a different light! Give thanks my friends, for the Lord is good and His steadfast love endures forever! Amen!


