What is your dream or hope for this new year? I will tell you what is my dream – my dream is that what Dr. Martin Luther King shared from the steps of the Lincoln Memorial in 1963. King's speech was not so much a speech as it was a sermon to a nation divided by race and politics. It was an appeal grounded in scripture to move beyond the teachings of "this world" to one where we see one another as sisters and brothers created by a loving God. It was a message of hope, not despair. I want to share the parts of the speech that inspire me. "I have a dream that one day this nation will rise up and live out the true meaning of its creed: "We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal." I have a dream that one day on the red hills of Georgia, the sons of former slaves and the sons of former slave owners will be able to sit down together at the table of brotherhood. I have a dream that my four little children will one day live in a nation where they will not be judged by the color of their skin but by the content of their character...one day right there in Alabama

I have a dream that one day every valley shall be exalted, and every hill and mountain shall be made low, the rough places will be made plain, and the crooked places will be made straight; "and the glory of the Lord shall be revealed and all flesh shall see it together."

Dr. King's speech is a message I take into 2024 because we are living in a time of deep divisions – racial, social, political, cultural, religious. What I see in the speech is the Christian message which is one of forgiveness, mercy, and hope. What I hear in King's message is an echo of Galatians 3 which says "So in Christ Jesus you are all children of God through faith, for all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. There is neither Jew nor Gentile, neither slave nor free, nor is there male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus. If you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise." In Christ Jesus the things that divide us from one another ought to fall away and no longer matter. We become a family that loves and cares for one another because we are sisters and brothers in Him. In the coming year, I pray that we as a congregation we will show our community what it means to live into the truth of this promise of Christ that inspired Dr. King.

May your New Year be filled with the love, peace, hope, and joy that only Christ can bring us! May your lives be filled to overflowing with abundant eternal life! Amen!

Faith Fest '24 is coming – Saturday, June 1, 2024 at the Mille Lacs County Fairgrounds starting at 12:00 – 6:00 PM. We will be offering: food, prayer area, children activities, special musicians and guest speakers, community resources, and other activities. We are seeking **VOLUNTEERS** – both to

serve on committees and help with the planning and also the day of the event. There will be sign up sheets posted after January 1st, 2024 in the Fellowship Hall, listing the various committees. **PLEASE** we need your help with this event. This year we are focusing on children, youth and young adults but anyone is welcome to attend. We, the Faith Fest group, feels that our children and youth are struggling and searching for something to believe in. We want them to know that they can believe in Christ and that he will see them through.

We have guest musicians that will be appearing – 7 Song (tells the story of the Bible in 7 songs and sponsored and paid for by Eternity Church), Jennifer Marie (Christian contemporary and also give testimony - \$1500); guest speakers – Jason Fath (Sponsored and paid for by Eternity Church), and other guest speakers, some of whom are not charging to appear.

We will have area resources available: health and wellness, veterans, addiction support, Red Cross, financial services, housing and other services that are available in the area.

Cross of Life church will be providing all paper products for the food area and also will be giving a cash donation. We are reaching out to other area businesses asking for their financial support. We have received a commitment from Crystal cabinets for \$350.00.

We are also having a Sing O gram event on Wednesday, February 14, where will be delivering candy grams, cookies, or flowers to resident in the area nursing homes and assisted living facilities in Milaca, Princeton and Zimmerman. All orders will be placed online and will be delivered between 9-12 and 1-4pm on February 14th. Youth groups from participating churches will be making heart shaped cookies that will be free, and to anyone who signs up in advance. We are working with Princeton Floral to supply flowers or small bouquets. If anyone want to sign up to sing or help with this fundraiser please do so on the sign up sheet in the Fellowship Hall.

We are also looking in to having another fundraiser – possibly in early April. More info will be posted on that event as we get the plans completed.

The most important thing is that we need VOLUNTEERS for this event. If, for some reason you feel you cannot physically help we would accept financial donations and your prayers to make this event successful.
