Single Board Meeting Minutes - August 13, 2024

Present: Linda O, Mark B, Scott L, Andrew H, Karen O, Gene S, Darren W

Absent: Michele E, Kevin F

- 1. Meeting Agenda approved.
- 2. Minutes from 5/11/24 were electronically approved.
- 3. Linda O reviewed 2024-2025 goals with the Board. It was suggested that if we are planning events to make sure and have Jenna advertise them on Facebook, etc. to help them be successful. A Hayride this Fall was suggested. Scott reported that the Men's Group is planning to meet Sept 7 led by Roger Leider & on Sat Sept 28 the group will be selling hot dogs at the event hosted by The Refuge in Zimmerman.
- 4. Financial reports-Linda O reported we are continuing in the 'negative' the past two months. Year-to-Date Income vs Expenses for June was -\$972.63 and at the end of July that collapsed to -\$3799.86. Elim Oasis Funds sitting with no use-The predetermined funds set aside for helping an eligible underfunded candidate for one month, Elim Oasis Funds, has laid dormant for years. The board discussed where to move these funds to. Gene S made a motion to move the funds to the Edward Jones Money Market account w/ the intent of moving \$5000 to a CD. Andrew 2nd, motion carried. Faith Fest-Scott L voiced the needs of Faith Fest & budgeting coming from the designated Youth Missions/Activities funds. The Board views Faith Fest as an outreach opportunity for the church. Andrew made a motion to allow Faith Fest to keep \$4000 of Freshwaters loan as working capital. \$1000 of the \$4000 will be donated to Faith Fest for 2024. Scott L 2nd, motion carried
- 5. Investments-Scott L gave an update on Investments. Scott also reported there was a gift of stock made which would cover 1 payment towards the Gerth property & also funds to the General budget. Gene made a motion to sell the gift of stock to apply to the Gerth Property fund & General Budget. Darren 2nd. Motion carried.
- 6. SPRC-Gene S provided an update on SPRC issues.
- 7. Trustees- Andrew H reported he will contact Linda Moran advising her Freshwaters will be purchasing our own Workers Compensation. The carpeting in front of the Restroom needs replacement this is being researched. Andrew also reported that Freshwaters insurance has increased & he is researching what other options we have that would have equivalent coverage but a lower price. Spencer Brook-Gene S reported he has made several calls to the Owner but with no success. He/Jenna will draft a letter & try to connect with Owner regarding the property matter. Andrew reported that the sidewalks were raised to mitigate safety issues.
- 8. 2025 Leadership-Linda O advised the Board to be thinking about who future Leaders could be, & status of our current Leaders.
- 9. Linda O closed the meeting with a prayer. Linda made a motion to adjourn, Andrew 2nd, motion carried, meeting adjourned.
