The meeting was called to order by Linda Olson at 7:00 PM. Present were Linda Olson, Carla Lusche, Philip Lingle, Kevin Fox, Darren Wesloh, Susan Kettelhodt, Andrew Harvala, Scott Liestman and Dave Halverson.

The agenda was approved and the minutes from 3/9/21 were approved electronically.

Two books by Thom Rainer were discussed to help discern our path forward as we reopen our church post Covid. 5 types of people who won't return and Autopsy of a Deceased Church were discussed. We feel the board is cognizant of the dangers of stagnation and are trying to position ourselves for the future with the streaming updates, youth programs and worship styles. We realize much more has to be done to engage the community at large and grow attendance.

Andrew updated us on the A/V updates, and exterior painting will begin with warmer weather.

Susan reviewed the financial reports. Giving is down \$4000 compared to last year, but expenses are also down \$7000. Expenses aren't expected to change drastically now that we have one building to maintain, but we will monitor them as we restart activities and building use.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:00 PM.

It touched our hearts, so we donated a quilt to the little girl and 2 plush blankets.

Every year we donate a quilt to the high school senior party, to homeless and shelters, Project Linus, and Pastor Kevin has access to quilts to donate to people in need. We are now giving a baby quilt to new babies who are baptized at Freshwaters.
