

SINGLE BOARD MEETING MINUTES

October 10, 2020

The meeting was held at MN Propane building following the planning session. Present were Linda Olson, Darren Wesloh, Andrew Harvala, Scott Liestman, Dave Halverson, Phil Lingle, and Kevin Fox.

The meeting was called to order by Linda at 1:30 pm.

The Agenda was approved as written, and the minutes from 9/8/20 had been approved electronically.

Kevin reviewed the nominations committee's progress.

Andrew reported for the Trustees. They will be finalizing bids for sanctuary repairs soon now that insurance benefits have been completed. Roof repairs are done. They are working with the PUC to switch to LED lights and go to a lower electric rate.

Roger presented the financial report. Giving remains steady but down about \$12,000 from a year ago. Expenses have also been lower. Our balance sheet looks good but we are still being supported from the \$20,000 grant from the Conference for the Youth Director position. We are planning to re-apply for the grant for next year, but will have to plan on covering that position if we do not get it. Current giving will not meet that expense, so Pastor Kevin will send a letter out to the congregation to remind people to keep up with giving.

The policy statements on endowments was reviewed and presented as follows:

Spending Policy for Endowment (Applegate and Smith)

Proceeds of this investment will not be relied on as part of the general budget of the church. This account is never to invade the original principal. All earnings beyond the original principal will be available at the discretion of the Trustees. If the account ever drops below the original principal invested due to investment performance, no access would be allowed.

Spending Policy of Zimmerman Sale Proceeds

Proceeds of this investment will not be relied on as part of the general budget of the church. Per the Bishop and the Minnesota Cabinet if the UMC, this account is to be left alone to be used at a later date for future building projects of the church. However, the dividends can be used for ministry purposes which may be above and beyond the general budget and/or capital improvements at the current location. This would include all dividends paid previously if they have not already been used. Dividends are typically paid on a quarterly basis and would be available at that time. The use of these funds will be at the discretion of the Single Board.

A motion was made and seconded, and the policies were approved as written.

Roger informed the Board that we received a grant from the Metcalf family in honor of Alex Metcalf for the amount of \$1400. A motion was made and passed to place those monies in the Investing in Congregation fund of the budget to be used for education.

Darren reported for the SPRC committee. The Pastor's evaluation has been completed and they have begun the work on the compensation package. They will perform an evaluation for Bethany also.

Due to Covid we will do a virtual annual meeting in a Charge Conference format, where only the Board will be present. All the information will be sent out to members in letter form, with any questions to be directed to Board members ahead of the meeting. The board will then vote on the annual package on December 15.

The next meeting is scheduled for November 10, 2020 at the church.

Meeting adjourned at 2:40
