# SINGLE BOARD MEETING MINUTES

**August 4, 2020**

Scott Liestman filled in as secretary until the next meeting when Phil Lingle will take over.

Meeting called to order at 7:00 by Linda Olson. Attending were Linda Olson, Roger Leider, Andrew Harvala, Dave Halverson, Scott Liestman, Kevin Fox, Darren Wesloh, and Phil Lingle.

Pastor Kevin started us off with a prayer.

We discussed potential candidates for the board for 2021 as several terms will expire.

The minutes of the June 9th meeting were already electronically approved.

**Trustee Report** by Andrew Harvala: The new dehumidifier has been installed. Painting has helped a lot to reduce the musty smell. Mint Roofing did some roof repairs as we had a few leaks from the recent heavy rains. Our insurance company is arguing the claim amount, Andrew is working through it with them. We are still planning to shampoo the carpets in the downstairs. We are still hoping to do some painting outside depending on how the settlement comes out?

**Financial report** by Roger Leider: We were supposed to be getting another \$10,000 grant from "Investing in Congregations" in July, but have not seen it yet. Kevin will write a letter to see if we should still expect it, or if things have changed due to the Covid 19? Our giving is down about \$4000 from last ytd. We feel very fortunate to be in the financial situation we are in and thank everyone for their continued giving.

Roger indicated his term of Treasurer will be done at the end of the year and to start looking for a replacement. If anyone is interested, please step forward.

**SPRC report** by Darren Wesloh: Kathy Walz would like to step down as choir director. Myla Tolmie is willing to take over provided we are able to have a choir soon?

**Pastor Kevin report:** In-person attendance has been low so the decision has been made to go back to one service starting August 16<sup>th</sup>. The service will be at 10am and be a blended service (traditional and contemporary). Online attendance has been good and despite attendance dropping during the live streaming, our overall hits are staying steady. Kevin will update the sound schedule since we are going to only one service. We are hoping to start Sunday School on Sept 13<sup>th</sup> with details to follow.

The endowment spending policies for both our Endowment and Zimmerman sale proceeds were discussed again.

The board agreed that any amount over the original \$500,000 principal received from the sale of the Zimmerman property could be available at the discretion of the **Single Board** as needed. If the principal should drop below the original amount, no access would be available until the account exceeds the original principal again. Linda will adjust the policy for approval at the next meeting.

We have set Oct 10<sup>th</sup> as a retreat date of the single board to look at the direction of the church and set some 1 year and 5 year goals. The meeting will be at Scott Liestman's home and will begin at 9am, ending around 3pm.

Elim Oasis is back running again with less than average attendance. We will continue to charge only 50% rent until they get back to full capacity.

Next meeting will be on Sept 8<sup>th</sup> at 7pm.

Motion to adjourn by Dave Halverson, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Roger. Leider. Adjourned at 8pm.

The Single Board will go on retreat in October to assess what our goals need to be in the next 5 years. What will be Freshwaters in 5 years' time? This is our prayerful question to God and for one another.
