URC™ will adhere to the date, time & meeting location of Weekend Rides. There may be occasional changes concerning the destination due to unforeseen circumstances.

URC™ Trips are subject to changes as determined by the Trip Ride Leader as may be necessary. All Trip Participants must register with the Trip Ride Leader so they may be included in the Trip Contact List.

CANCELLATION POLICY:

URC™ Ride Cancellations will be sent to all current URC™ members with contact information on file.

Notices may be sent by Email or Text.

Ride cancellation notices will be sent 2 1/2 hours prior to Kick Stands Up for the affected ride.

Weather Related Cancellation Guidelines:

A ride will be canceled if the forecasted high temperature for the day is not expected to exceed 50°F at the meeting or destination location.

A ride will also be canceled if the forecast calls for a 40% or greater chance of rain at the meeting location, destination, or along the planned route.

The ride leader has the option to change the destination to avoid cancelling the ride.
