## Terrific Treat Recipes!!!

#### **Braunschweiger Brownies**

8 oz Braunschweiger mixed with enough liquid to make it soupy

- 1 c tapioca flour (starch)
- 1 ½ c whole wheat (or other) flour more liquid

Preheat oven to 350.

Add enough liquid to and blend by hand with the braunschweiger to make a soupy mix. Mix in eggs. Mix in tapioca flour. Add flour and enough liquid to make a batter that is about the consistency of cake batter. Pour into 7x9 pan lined with oiled foil. Shake the pan or run a butter knife through the batter to remove bubbles.

Bake for 40 minutes or so, depending on your oven. Check at 20 minutes and 30 minutes to see if the cake is "blowing up." Puncture if it is. I've only had this happen once when I was using a drier meat, but it was spectacular. Allow to cool on a rack before cutting.

**Old Business:** Nothing at this time.



## Dog Sports Profile: Flyball

(Adapted from the AKC website)

Flyball is one of the most exciting dog sports offered. It's fast and loud! Each team has four dogs competing against other four-dog teams. You can literally feel the anticipation in the air as the dogs line up and wait for a Flyball relay race to begin. As soon as the gun fires, each dog dashes over a line of low hurdles to reach a box. Once there, they use their paws to push a spring-loaded pad and release a tennis ball into the air that they catch and bring back to their handlers. Once back to the starting line, the next dog takes his turn.

In partnership with the North American Flyball Association (NAFA), AKC recognizes four titles: Flyball Dog Champion (FDCH), Flyball Master (FM), ONYX and Flyball Grand Champion (FGDCH). Owners can request these titles be recognized on their dog's AKC record by completing a simply Title Application.

Flyball instruction and trials are offered several places along the Front Range. Go check it out! Flyball might be your next sport! Dogs of all sizes are welcome!
