AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES CHEYENNE KENNEL CLUB - ALL THREE DAYS

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.



“DON’T FORGET TO CHECK THE OWNER-HANDLED BOX ON THE ENTRY FORM IF ENTERING THIS COMPETITION.”



All dogs that are owner-handled and are not exhibited in the National Owner-Handled Series by professional handlers* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward’s book & the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition during the entire show. A current assistant is defined by anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend, however current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.**

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are competing in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed, or in Best of Winners competition.

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers’ organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.*

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards★, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards★, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards★, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards★ in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards★ in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards★ in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

MASTER CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show and who have won ten (10) Best Junior Handler awards with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

★ A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition counts as one win towards moving to Open.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.

Section 1 - Classifications

- The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for puppies that are over four months of age but under six months on the day of the event.
- Classes are offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3 Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show
- The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show

Section 2 - Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- Puppies must have one of the following:
 - An Individual registration number registered with the American Kennel Club (AKC)
 - A Foundation Stock Service (FSS) registration number
 - A foreign born dog may enter if they are registered in the country of origin, as defined in Chapter 11, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. Entries must be marked "Exhibition Only" prior to the close of entries.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by the forenamed may compete for awards in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.
- Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month Beginner Puppy Competition.

Entries open at 8:00 AM and close at 11:30 AM, or when the numerical limit has been reached, on Saturday, August 31, 2024 at the catalog sales table.

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship class. The Pee Wee class is geared toward children 5 to under 9 years of age at all shows offering Pee Wee.

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

- A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.
- Dogs must be registered
- Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. If pre-entered, a dog may be substituted that meets the eligibility requirements as specified by the club.
- All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.
- All AKC fully recognized, Miscellaneous Class & FSS breeds & All American Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program are allowed to enter, including dogs with a PAL listing.
- In addition to an entry, a release must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian. Release forms will be available at the show.

The safety of both the dogs and Juniors inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. An additional lead, provided by the Club, will be at the Judge's table. At the Judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.



Although the word “judge” will be used, this is designed to be a learning and mentoring experience—no Junior will be “judged” but rather will be mentored with the age appropriate amount of information to help prepare them for what they will be expected to know about AKC regular Junior Showmanship once they reach 9 years of age. The children will be mentored one child, their adult, and dog in the ring at a time.

The Judge should explain the process of showing the dog to the Junior and the responsible adult in the ring including breed specific presentation. Depending on the size of the dog and the child, the adult may be asked to lift a table breed on or off the table, or the Club may mandate that the adult should do it regardless. Neither the youngster nor the adult should be asked to show the bite.

A group photo will be taken after all the pre-Junior Showmanship entrants have been in the ring. Parents are asked to stay for the photo. Children only, no dogs.

1. The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 3:00 pm on Friday. Building will close at 10:00 pm each night. NO EXCEPTIONS. The building will be open at 6:00 am each event morning. NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING OVERNIGHT. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on Monday.
2. Groups may be judged two at a time all three days.
3. No parking within 30 feet of the show building. Please observe the NO Parking & RESERVED parking areas. Unauthorized vehicles parked in fire lanes, loading and or reserved parking areas are subject to being towed at the owner's expense. Overnight RV Parking is on a reserved basis only by the Laramie County Fairgrounds. Additional Reserved parking is for Judges, Stewards, Handicap Parking, Vendors & Cheyenne Kennel Club members.
4. Unloading zones are available on the South side of the building. Please Note: Time limit for unloading/loading is 20 minutes. Vehicles left parked in the loading zone may be towed at the owner's expense.
5. Reserved Grooming spaces will only be made online through our PayPal store. Spaces and electricity are very limited. If you would like electricity you must reserve a space with access. Electrical cords across walkways and aisles must be fully taped down. If you use an ex-pen in your space with shavings, please place plastic on the floor and up the sides of the ex-pens to control the shavings and mess. Please leave your grooming space like you found it, CLEAN, if not you could be denied reserved grooming at any of our future shows.
6. Open/free grooming will be in the dirt barn on the East end of the building. **The outside barn stalls will NOT be available this year.** Please leave your grooming space like you found it, CLEAN.
7. Please respect the needs of other exhibitors by setting up ringside crates 20 minutes prior to judging of your breed & removing them within 20 minutes of end of judging of your breed. An exception is made for winners awaiting breaks for pictures. Persons violating this schedule will be asked to remove their crates. Grooming tables are NOT allowed ringside with the exception of toy breeds using ringside tables or exhibitors preparing for group judging. Group dogs may be staged no earlier than 30 minutes prior to groups.
8. No extension cords will be permitted to lead from inside the buildings to the outside areas.
9. No baby or animal strollers are permitted on the main floor of the building. Children must be under adult supervision. No roller blades, scooters, bikes or skate-boards permitted in the building.
10. LIMITED dog bathing facilities will be available, **with cold water only.** Bring your own hose.
11. The show committee must prepare the building each night for the next day's competition. **Any crates or chairs left ringside on the main floor of the building may be removed to a holding area and a \$10.00 fee assessed. Any crates left in temporary crating after Best in Show will be moved to temporary storage by the Show Committee. A \$10.00 fee will be charged.** You will need to see the Show Chair to retrieve any items left at the end of the day.
12. The Cheyenne Kennel Club & Laramie County Fairgrounds assumes NO RESPONSIBILITY for personal injury, death of any person, theft or injury or death of any animal, damage or loss of property while at or on the show grounds or in transit to or from the show.
13. This is a self-cleaning show, all exhibitors are expected to clean-up after themselves and their dogs.
14. **Cheyenne Kennel Club has taken Event Committee action against exhibitors because dogs were left in life threatening conditions. Don't be our next statistic!**
15. NO SMOKING OR VAPOR CIGARETTES ARE ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING
16. PLEASE, DO NOT ALLOW dogs to urinate on building walls, draping, posts or trash cans. THANK YOU FOR YOUR DUE DILIGENCE.

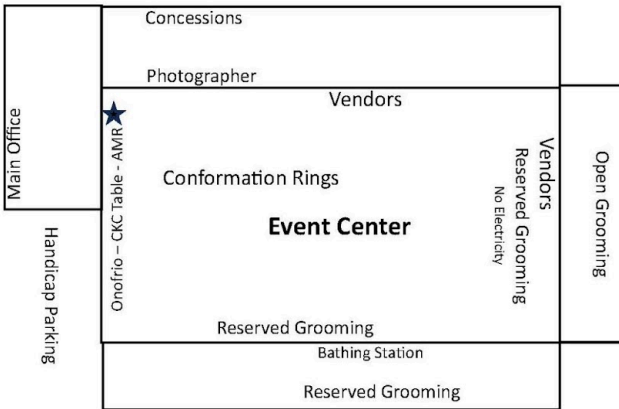
