Code of Ethics

This code shall establish a standard of conduct to be followed by all members of the Cheyenne Kennel Club in the normal course of breeding, selling, and exhibiting purebred dogs. All situations cannot be covered and for this reason any failure to comply with the intent of this code shall be handled in the same manner as a specific violation.

As a general dog fancier, I agree to the following:

1. I will consider the welfare of my dogs above personal gain or profit.
2. I will maintain the best possible standards of sanitation, health, and general care for my dogs.
3. As a person dedicated to my breed, I pledge to help educate the public in the Breed Standards of AKC and to help and assist any novice fancier/breeder to the best of my ability.
4. I pledge to always exhibit good sportsmanship and conduct myself in a manner representative of the principles upon which the Cheyenne Kennel Club was founded. I will not speak unjustly of others in dog sports, nor of their dogs or their kennels and I will not speak unjustly of the Cheyenne Kennel Club.
5. I agree to support the Cheyenne Kennel Club by volunteering my time to serve on committees and participate in club activities.
6. I agree to abide by the Constitution and By-Laws of the Cheyenne Kennel Club, and the rules and regulations of the American Kennel Club.
7. All prospective members shall be given a copy of the Code of Ethics when applying for membership, and by the act of joining shall signify their acceptance of this code in its entirety. Any member who violates this code in either content or intent shall be punished according to the severity and intent of the violation up to and including expulsion from the club.
8. The Board of Directors shall serve as the Ethics Board and shall hear all cases of violation.

If I am also a breeder I agree to the following:

1. I will be responsible for any dog I have bred. If necessary, I will assist with rehoming any dog I have bred.
2. I will limit my breeding programs to those breeds of which I have sufficient knowledge to make a positive contribution and I will always strive to breed for the improvement of the Breed as exemplified by the AKC Breed Standard.
3. I will not knowingly allow any of my dogs to be sold through public retail pet shops, puppy mills, or any facility in which multiple breeders or multiple litters are brought together for the purpose of sales to the public, nor will I condone such operations. Nor shall I give or allow my dogs to be given as prizes at contests or exploited to the detriment of the breed.
4. I will refuse stud service to any unregistered bitch, to any bitch I consider in poor health, of unsound temperament, or having physical limiting hereditary faults.
5. Upon selling a dog of less than breeding quality, I will provide limited registration papers.
6. I will fairly represent to any interested parties any stock offered for sale and will not use misleading or untruthful statements in selling or advertising. The use of sales contracts is recommended to cover any guarantees and agreements relative to the sale with signed copies to each party involved.
