

## Best Fit Examples

Example Applicant	Best Session Choice
10-year-old with Down Syndrome; Needs help washing hair and after bowel movements; will often refuse non-preferred activities but is typically able to be redirected; has behaviors including yelling and slapping at teachers about 1x per month; receives speech and OT services	Therapy Camp
14-year-old with ADHD; independent in ADLs; has difficulty with social skills and does not have many close friends in the school setting; receives occupational therapy in a clinical setting	Skills Camp
8-year-old with genetic condition; g-tube fed; non-ambulatory, non-verbal; loves being outside and interacting with others; receives speech, OT, and PT services.	Medical Respite Camp
11-year-old with ASD; verbal but mostly scripting; ambulatory; needs prompting to complete showers, dressing, and toileting; independent with eating and mobility; has a limited number of preferred foods; elopes from activities but typically stays in the same room; short attention span	Recreation Camp
15-year-old; ASD; receives Speech and OT services; struggles with social skills; is dysregulated by changes in schedule, not winning or being first, has some sensory issues	Therapy Camp OR Skills Camp depending on cognitive level and level of independence in ADLs
12- year-old with CP; non-ambulatory; can transfer independently and needs minimal assistance with ADLs including help transferring to shower chair and washing hair; learning disabilities	Therapy Camp (possibly Skills camp depending on cognitive and independence levels)
10-year-old with ASD; independent in ADLs; mild intellectual disabilities; ODD and behavior disorders; daily outbursts including hitting, kicking, and spitting; frequently uses inappropriate language; does not respond well to redirection; mom wants student to attend, but if student is asked about camp, he screams and cries saying he does not want to go	Not a good fit for camp at this time
