Who is not a good fit?

Students who

- have a high level of behavioral needs or are physically aggressive
- are not receptive to behavioral interventions
- are not interested in attending a summer camp and actively participating

Who is a good fit?

Students who:

- have an intellectual, emotional or behavioral disability or disorder
- require one on one staffing due to elopement, attendance to task, or mild behavioral needs
- require moderate assistance to complete activities of daily living
- would benefit from a summer camp experience
- would benefit from forming friendships with peers and positive role models
