You could save the life of someone like Ismail

Ismail is desperately searching for his lifesaving stem cell donor.

Baby Ismail has already faced extreme challenges in his short life. At just seven months old he has been diagnosed with a rare autoimmune disorder called IPEX, and his family has been told that a stem cell transplant is his only hope of survival. But so far, no matching donor can be found on the register. Ismail's dad, Kawser, said: "Without a transplant, his future is not looking good."

The family's South Asian heritage means it is even harder for Ismail to find a donor so they are appealing to people in their community and beyond to encourage as many people as possible to sign up to be a potential lifesaver.
