



Private Track Rental Agreement

1. Track rental fees are based on the date and time requested. Track management will quote rental fees once dates have been confirmed.
2. Track rentals are for 4 hours, non-groomed/watered unless otherwise requested. Additional fees for extra time and or groomed/watered track.
3. There is a **MAXIMUM** of 10 riders allowed during track rental. There is a \$30 fee for each additional rider.
4. Everyone must sign a release and waiver upon arrival at the track.
5. Riders under the age of 18 must sign a minor release form and have a parent or guardian sign a release.
6. No riding in the pits or grass areas of the park.
7. To be eligible to ride the track you must have proper safety equipment. Riders are required to have Motocross boots, Helmet, and proper pants and shirt. Helmets must be worn at all times while operating motorized O.H.V. in the park.
8. Anyone damaging property, disrespecting park employees or breaking any park rules will be ejected from the park. No Refunds will be given.
9. Should it rain prior to your rental date, you will have the option to rescheduled to another date. Should it rain after the start of your rental, No refunds will be given.
10. A \$100 non-refundable deposit is required at the time of agreement; remaining balance is due at the start of rental.
11. By signing this agreement, you agree to all said rules of this agreement and attached park rules and regulations.

Rules and Regulations

ALL ATV, motorcycle operators, and spectators must complete required forms and pay appropriate fees at the park office immediately upon entering the park.

Park and EVERYONE MUST come in to sign in. No fee for spectators on practice days, but they MUST sign in.

MINOR OPERATORS (UNDER 18 YEARS OLD):

- Anyone under 18 years old must have parents or legal guardian in attendance within the park.
- All operators under the age of 18 must have both parents sign **notarized** Consent and Release Forms.

ATV'S AND MOTORCYCLES:

- ATV's and motorcycles are not to exceed 5 mph while in parking lot and are to proceed in a safe and controlled manner to the track area.
- Passengers are not allowed on ATV's or motorcycles.
- All operators must be able to submit proof of age.
- All operators must wear appropriate safety equipment while riding on the track and pits. As a minimum, operators must have a helmet, eye protection and appropriate footwear. Riding privileges may be denied if management determines an operator is not meeting minimum safety requirements in their attire.
- South of the Ozark Motocross has an absolute sobriety rule. An ATV or motorcycle operator shall consume no alcohol. **IF YOU DRINK, YOU CANNOT RIDE!!!!**
- Riding outside designated areas will result in suspension from the park for that day. A 2nd offense may result in suspension of riding privileges for 30 days at the park attendant's discretion. A 3rd offense may result in suspension for the balance of the year.
- Every ATV and motorcycle must meet state and federal noise and air pollution standards.
- No three-wheelers are allowed in the Park.

PARK RULES:



- All operators shall operate their vehicles in a safe and controlled manner and respect the rights of others using the pit area, track and facilities. Operators shall obey all signs that direct vehicular traffic or established rules for park use.
- Misuse or abuse of park equipment and facilities will result in expulsion from the park and suspension of riding privileges for up to a year at the park attendant's discretion. Violators will be subject to prosecution for any damages.
- All litter shall be disposed of in proper waste receptacles. Operators shall be responsible for any debris caused or left by their vehicles.
- All pets are to be on a leash or properly restrained to prevent injury or nuisance to other park patrons.
- Any personal injury or property damage must be reported to the management and/or its employees.
- All rules and regulations may be enforced by ordinance or by rules and regulations established by the State of Arkansas Statutes.
- Violation of park rules and regulations will result in: 1st offense-expulsion from the park for that day. A 2nd offense may result in suspension of riding privileges for 30 days at the park. A 3rd offense may result in suspension for the balance of the year.
