## A Message from Your Treasurer



Thank you for your continued commitment to Holy Innocents'. We have remained solvent throughout the Covid pandemic and the inflation that has challenged everyone's budget. Your partnership is essential in helping us to continue to move forward and maintain our strong financial position. We are watching closely as payroll costs, utility expenses and insurance go up. With your continued faithful pledges, we expect to reasonably estimate and budget to meet our operational expenses for the coming year.



These are some examples of areas that we have seen the most increases:

Payroll: The diocese recommended Cost of Living Increase for clergy is 4.5% and we are expecting a similar or higher recommendation for 2023.

Utilities: Year-to-date our expenditures are up over 32%. Thankfully this makes up only about 7% of our budget. Consumption was greatly reduced in the Rectory with the installation of gas hot water baseboard heat and tankless domestic hot water systems during the renovations in 2018. Good for the environment and good for our budget!

Our budget for 2023 represents both emergent necessities and promising possibilities. The biggest challenges are the capital expenditures required to maintain and replace key elements of our building, which is nearly half a century old. You undoubtedly are aware of the fundraising campaign to remodel the Parish Hall Kitchen with the hope that we can also replace the flooring throughout Martin Hall. Another area in need of repair is the parking lot, which requires repairs, maintenance and sealing. We are currently gathering estimates for both projects.

We have much to hope for in the year ahead, and your gifts help us to plan and meet these expenditures to maintain our building and grounds as well as to uphold and improve our worship, ministries, and missions. With your giving estimate, know that we will be able to keep the lights on, building warm and fully staffed. Any surplus in the budget is able to be used towards our capital projects.

Thanks to your generosity and faithfulness, those who call Holy Innocents' home understand the sheer power of working together and how it allows us to thrive together.
