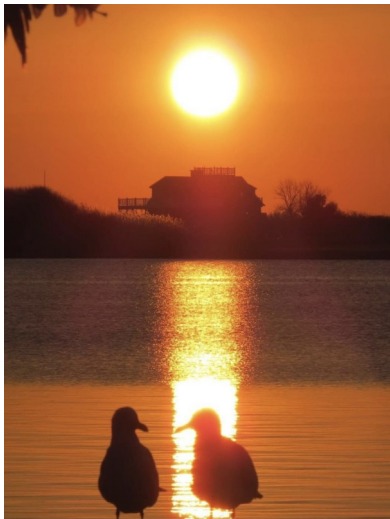

Coffee Grounds and Your Garden

Did you know coffee grounds are a great organic addition to your garden? Our Coffee Hours leave us with plenty of used coffee grounds and we have been composting them since the winter, then using them around the property to nourish our plantings. The grounds are nitrogen-rich and can improve the soil, if used properly.

Here are a few tips if you'd like to use your leftover grounds in the garden:

- First, never use freshly ground coffee on your plants, only use spent grounds. The best way to use them is by adding them to your compost pile where they can break down. They act as a nitrogen-rich material and slowly release nitrogen, calcium and magnesium as they decompose.
- If you want to apply them directly to your soil or plants, use them in moderation, sprinkling a thin layer directly onto the soil and rake in. Avoid using with seedlings or young plants.
- Coffee grounds can help to deter slugs, snails and ants, too!
- If you want to begin a compost pile with your coffee grounds, follow this "recipe": 3 parts leaves, 1 part grass clippings, and 1 part *cooled* coffee grounds. (Hot grounds can kill the beneficial organisms!) Turn weekly. Avoid exceeding 20% coffee grounds. Leave the pile outside for a few months or just leave your grounds alone outside, then use them.

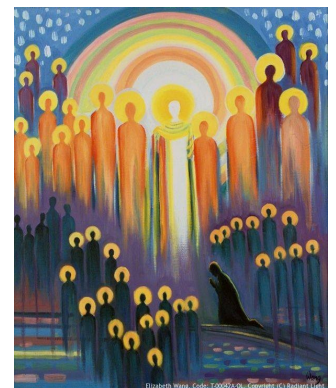
Mark your calendar for Bishop Sally French's visit recognizing Mother's Erin's ministry as Rector of Holy Innocents'!
