Your wedding day goes by fast, but your film keeps those memories alive forever.

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These timelines are just an example of weddings that I've been a part of but by no means is the perfect answer. This is your day, we are just here to guide and help in any way we can!

If you have a unique or different schedule I am totally for that! Going against the normal "wedding timeline" is always encouraged with us.

Keep us updated on your plans and we'll be here to help along the way!

I like to work backwards in 30 minute time chunks from the ceremony time. This builds in time for some breaks and if something is delayed a little bit, there is time to catch back up by doing this.

Depending on your ceremony time, working backwards like this will help you with your hair and makeup artists on how much time they need and when you would need to arrive to start getting hair and makeup.

This is just the middle of the day help. We are very go with the flow and can make anything work. These are just tips for when things usually fall in place. Things will change and timing of the year can make sunset times vary and so on.

Hope this helps you as you start to plan your day!

FAQ'S

Q: Is the reservation fee/deposit refundable?

A: The initial retainer is non-refundable. This is required to secure your date.

Q: Can you shoot both photo/video for our wedding?

A: Yes & No, let me explain. While shooting photography, I can do a hybrid with video and deliver a 2-3 minute highlight video. This is different than my full videography highlight films. Please ask if you are interested!

Q: How do you accept payment?

A: Payments are processed through Pixieset. You will receive an invoice that you can pay easily with setup reminders. Card payments, Venmo & PayPal methods are available.

Q: What time do you arrive and how long will you stay?

A: After checking out the day of timeline, we decide when the best time for us to arrive is (we communicate with you before to be sure we are not missing out on any special moments before makeup). We like to arrive during makeup and hair and leave once 10 hours is up, we'll make sure to capture plenty of dance floor footage as well!

Q: What is your turnaround time?

A: My turnaround time is something I take pride in, you are excited to see your wedding day and I'm excited to show you! My contract states you will get your photos or video back in 6-8 weeks.

*If you think of anything else, please reach out! Can't wait to talk further!

Q: Do your prices include tax?

A: YES! Taxes are covered on our end.

Q: Do you include drone footage?

A: Yes! Drone footage is included with all of our video packages. (Weather/Location permitting)

Q: What do you shoot with and are you insured?

A: We shoot with 4K Sony full frame mirrorless cameras and yes we have equipment and liability insurance.

Q: How do you pick music?

A: Music for our films is super important and we take plenty of time to make sure the music fits the vibe of the day. We do have to use legally licensed music from Musicbed and Epidemic Sound.

Q: Do you post everything you shoot online?

A: Highlight films are typically posted online on Instagram, Facebook and YouTube unless specifically requested not to.

Q: What is your deposit and payment plan?

A: I do a retainer of \$1,000 to secure your date. The remainder is split up typically 50% of the remainder due 90 days before your wedding date and the last 50% due 7 days before the big day.

Q: Do you travel?

A: Of course!! We have traveled to California, Colorado, Illinois, Indiana, South Carolina, Florida, Mexico & Jamaica over the last few years. We love to jump on a plane and spend a few days with you. Email me to talk details on costs.

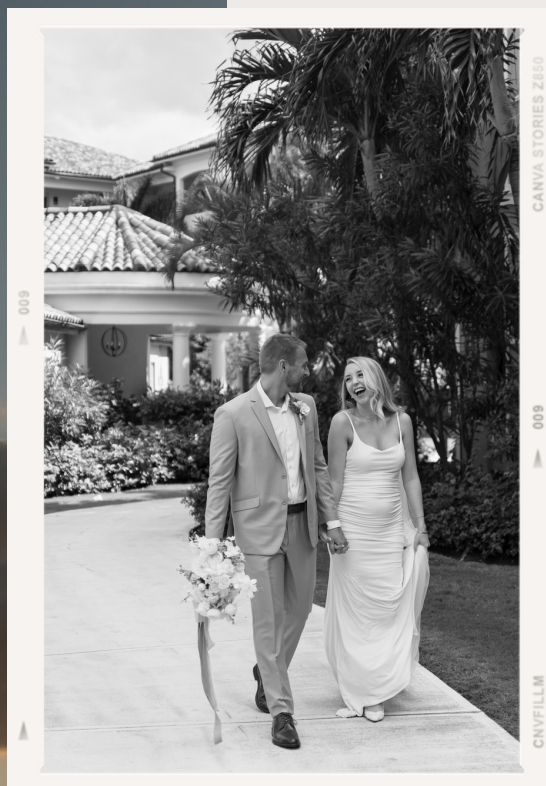

bride prep tips



Tip #1 – Soak it all in.

- Laugh with your girls, sip a mimosa, listen to your favorite playlist, and enjoy the morning. Some of the best memories happen before the ceremony even begins.

Tip #2 – Light is everything.

- If possible, get ready near big windows with lots of natural light. I'll often turn off the overhead lights, they usually add an orange color that isn't very flattering in photos or video.

Tip #3 – Have your details ready.

- Set aside your dress, shoes, jewelry, perfume, invitation suite, rings, vows, and any sentimental items before I arrive. It'll save time and ensure I can capture all the little details that help tell your story.

groom prep tips



Tip #1 – Enjoy the morning.

- The morning goes by faster than you think. Hang out with your groomsmen, have a drink (if that's your thing), put on your favorite playlist, and soak it all in. You don't need to perform for the camera just enjoy the people you're with and let me document it naturally.

Tip #2 – Keep the room bright and uncluttered.

- Natural window light makes a huge difference in your photos. If possible, get ready in the brightest room available and keep bags, clothes, and random items tucked into one corner. If lighting isn't the best, don't worry we'll find a good spot to do finishing touches.

Tip #3 – Trust the process.

- I'll give you a little direction when it's time to button your jacket, adjust your tie, or put on your watch, but the rest of the morning is all about capturing real moments. No awkward posing just genuine interactions, laughs, and anticipation before you see your bride.

first look tips



If you decide to have a first look (which I highly recommend) we will find you a beautiful spot to do your first look. This is time that will just be the two of you on your special day. It's nice to see each other and embrace each other before you walk down the aisle. This way you can also get all of your family photos/video done before the ceremony. This frees up time to do whatever you want after your ceremony, hang with your bridal party, go to a bar, get on a party bus or just start mingling with your guests before dinner.

I mic up the groom during the first look and this creates amazing sound bites for your video. It is such an intimate & raw moment between the two of you, you'll be surprised how sweet & how many tears are shed from your almost new husband or wife!



Tip #1 - Act as if there aren't cameras there. I know this may be easier said than done but once you get in this moment it's easy for all your worries and thoughts to go out the window. Just embrace each other & enjoy the moment!

Tip #2 - Show each other off! Take time to look at her dress & his suit. You both look great, so tell each other! Don't rush to be done and look at the camera, take your time and talk with your about to be wife/husband and cherish it.

Tip #3 - Leave your belongings with your groomsmen/bridesmaids, you don't want things in your pockets or have to set anything down that will get in the way of each other.

Extra Tip - Have tissues on hand, this is my favorite part of the day hands down! Love the raw moments it captures

This list is to help you and your significant other to cover the basics. This is not a perfect list and every family is different, just something to help you start your list of photos you need to capture the day of your wedding

I believe it is best to shoot these photos BEFORE the ceremony starts, so the couple & their guests can head straight into cocktail hour after the ceremony & you don't have to worry about rounding up family members.





engagement photos

I approach engagement sessions a little differently than most photographers. Instead of treating it like a photoshoot, I like to treat it like a date night. Rather than standing in one spot for an hour taking posed photos, let's do something that feels like you. Grab a drink at your favorite bar, have a pizza picnic, rent a bike, go to the movie theater, explore downtown, visit your favorite coffee shop, or spend the evening doing an activity you genuinely enjoy together. If you don't have a specific idea, don't worry, I have plenty of location suggestions.

My philosophy is simple: the more natural the experience, the more genuine the photos will be. When you're focused on each other instead of the camera, your personalities come through, and that's where the best images happen. The best part? I don't put a time limit on engagement sessions. We'll take our time, hang out, chat, and create photos that actually feel like your relationship, not just another item to check off the wedding planning list.
