groom prep tips



- Tip #1 - Relax & have fun with your boys, it doesn't take long for you to get ready so sit back, have fun and drink a few before your big day
- Tip #2 - Find a spot with good natural lighting. Think about windows where a lot of light comes in. This makes for good shots of you getting ready and putting on your final touches of your suit, tie & details
- Tip #3 - We'll stage a few moments of you getting ready but know we'll just be documenting you hanging with your groomsmen otherwise, so don't mind the camera following you around. I like to keep it casual & fun so don't worry, we'll have fun!

Another side note, I will get detailed shots in during this time of the dress, shoes, invites, rings, etc. Please have these things together or a bridesmaid/personal attendant have these things organized. We love to capture details of all of your special things before the day gets going.



- Tip #1 - Relax & have fun with your girls, drink some mimosas, get your hair done and soak it all in!
- Tip #2 - Find a spot with good natural lighting. Think about windows where a lot of light comes in. This makes for good shots of you getting ready, makeup/hair final touches. I like to shut off the lights for some moody & flattering video. Those gross orange room lights aren't the the prettiest on your face.
- Tip #3 - We'll stage a few moments of you getting ready but know we'll just be documenting you hanging with your bridesmaids otherwise, so don't mind the camera following you around. I like to keep it casual & fun so don't worry, we'll have fun!

first look tips



If you decide to have a first look (which I highly recommend) we will find you a beautiful spot to do your first look. This is time that will just be the two of you on your special day. It's nice to see each other and embrace each other before you walk down the aisle. This way you can also get all of your family photos/video done before the ceremony. This frees up time to do whatever you want after your ceremony, hang with your bridal party, go to a bar, get on a party bus or just start mingling with your guests before dinner.

I mic up the groom during the first look and this creates amazing sound bites for your video. It is such an intimate & raw moment between the two of you, you'll be surprised how sweet & how many tears are shed from your almost new husband or wife!



Tip #1 - Act as if there aren't cameras there. I know this may be easier said than done but once you get in this moment it's easy for all your worries and thoughts to go out the window. Just embrace each other & enjoy the moment!

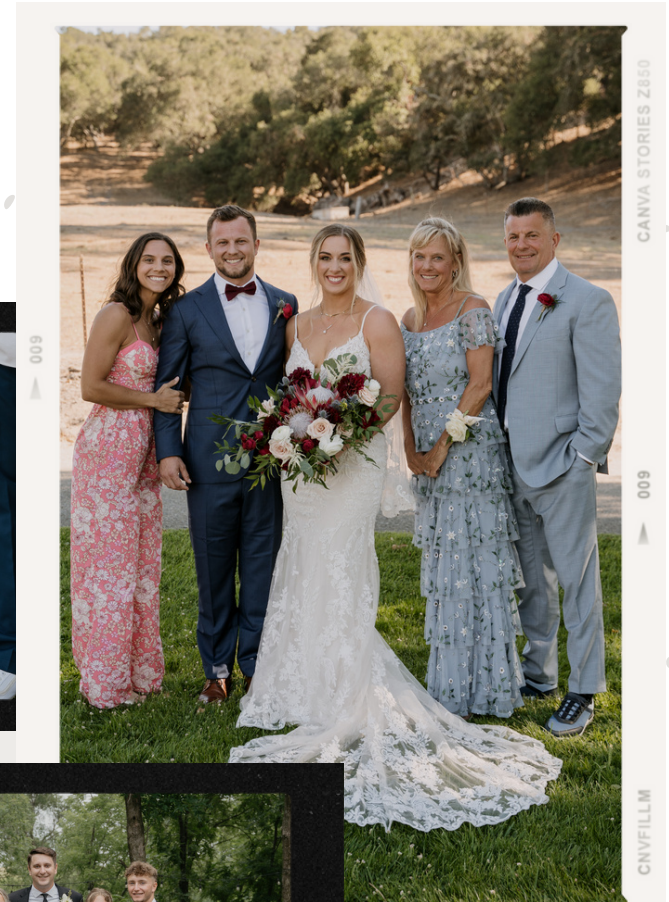
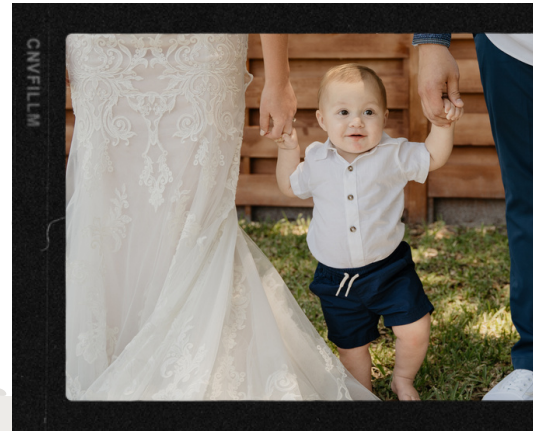
Tip #2 - Show each other off! Take time to look at her dress & his suit. You both look great, so tell each other! Don't rush to be done and look at the camera, take your time and talk with your about to be wife/husband and cherish it.

Tip #3 - Leave your belongings with your groomsmen/bridesmaids, you don't want things in your pockets or have to set anything down that will get in the way of each other.

Extra Tip - Have tissues on hand, this is my favorite part of the day hands down! Love the raw moments it captures

1:30	FIRST LOOK
2:00	BRIDAL PARTY
2:30	FAMILY PHOTOS
3:00	BRIDE & GROOM PHOTOS
4:00	CEREMONY
5:00	COCKTAIL HOUR
6:00	DINNER
7:00	SUNSET PHOTOS
7:30	DANCES

This is just an example timeline to help you for your big day. Things will change and timing of the year can make sunset times vary and so on.

other tips & suggestions



Give us your wedding timeline - Please give us a rough estimate of your wedding day :) Just know things will change and that's okay!! This just gives us a heads up on where to be and when so we are well prepared to capture all of your special moments. This will also help you make your day as seamless as possible. We are pros at this and can get people where they need to be when they need to be there.

Seating Your Vendors - A meal should be provided for your photographers and videographers. Think about putting these vendors together at a decently placed table. That way when speeches & toasts happen we are there & ready to capture those moments or something that happens quickly we can catch it!

Wedding Cake Placement - Consider having it front and center. Too often brides put their cakes on the side or back of their reception and nobody can see. Display that cake you spent good money on proudly and share that moment with all of your guests!
