

Affidavit Instructions

Thank you for acting and for your time to complete this Affidavit. We need Americans to take a stand and support the Brunson brothers' case. If you want a chance of saving America, it is up to all of us to act now. We the People can do this, if we simply spread the word and take the time to flood the Supreme Court with these Affidavits. Each one of us has a duty to protect our constitution and to serve notice of our grievances.

Action is required, share this Affidavit with everyone you know and get at least two others to send in this affidavit too. It's up to us!

It will require for you to fill in your personal information in the red lettered areas of the Affidavit. You are encouraged to add in your current "citizenship" whether it is U.S. citizen, Naturalized citizen or non-citizen national of the united States, which is the status the AA process gets you to.

After you have completed putting your information in the red areas, you will need to select the black color under the font and change the red to black of the red-letter information. Then print two copies, one to mail and one for your records. Have both notarized with wet ink.

Next, you will need to take the Affidavit to a Notary to have notarized.

(Do **not sign the affidavit until the notary says it's ok to**)

After the Notary has executed their notary signature and seal, you can then proceed to mail one of the notarized original Affidavits to the Supreme Court. Keep the second original Affidavit in a safe place.

Scan your affidavit and make a PDF file.

Go to:

(If the link doesn't work, you can google "Supreme Court Contact".

Then Click on Public Information Office.

That will take you to the "Contact Us- Public Information Office", page.)

Fill out form info and attach executed Letter in box provided.

Affix signature to letter.

You should get immediate online proof of receipt and later email verifying receipt.
