Affidavit of Inhabitance Instruction Page

- The Declaration of Inhabitance is for those born in (DC) District of Columbia and outlying islands like Puerto Rico, Guam, American Samoa, US Virgin Islands and Northern Mariana Islands. This document "AOI" needs to be sent to the Secretary of State of the United States, i.e., Antony J Blinken and the Secretary of State of the State in which you live/inhabit.
- 2. The "AOI" will need to be sent by Registered Mail to the US Secretary of State. Certified mail can be used for the State Secretary of State that you are currently inhabiting, although we advise sending the document Registered mail to both recipients. Be sure to ask for a Return Receipt (green card) to be included, ensuring that you check (<u>Adult Signature</u> or <u>Signature</u> <u>Confirmation</u>) both wouldn't hurt.
- 3. In helping you get more accurate time in which you can record your AOI packet, you may want to visit <u>https://tools.usps.com/go/TrackConfirmAction!input.action</u> to track.
- 4. Note: if you did NOT receive the Green Return Receipt card "date stamped" Registered or Certified Mail back from any government agencies, take your USPS printed receipt back to the Post Office. Kindly have them print out the proof of delivery / signature confirmation from their computer system stating your packet was received, which will include the date received and signature.
- 5. Also, as a tip for later use, purchase a three-pack of scotch tape. Attach the returned Certified Green card hardcopies to the Certified Proof of Service form by applying a 6-inch strip of scotch tape across the upper edge of the card to the paper.
- 6. Make sure to wait 21 days after the Secretary of State of the United States receives your Affidavit of Inhabitance, ensuring a time on or after the 22nd day to notarize and mail your next document, the AoR, which you will find in the "Born in America Freedom Bundle" on our website.
- 7. Make sure that you autograph your packet in Red Ink along with a red thumb print that just touches the last letter in your Last name. Use syntax form like this: First-Middle; Last Name
- 8. Recording the Declaration of Inhabitation packet should include:
 - 1. Recording Cover Sheet
 - 2. Declaration of Inhabitation
 - 3. Certified Proof of Service
 - 4. Judgement of Unrebutted Affidavit
- Note: if you are having trouble recording at your county's Recorders office, you may want to record your document in either La-Paz or Pima County Arizona. Information for Pima County, Arizona is on our website.
