





This was a replacement for a 1906 vintage Shrine Auditorium at 649 W. Jefferson Blvd. that had burned in 1920. The \$2.5 million for the new building was raised from public subscriptions as well as contributions from Shrine organizations. It was first known as the **Los Angeles Civic Auditorium**. In 1931 it was being advertised as the **Shrine Civic Auditorium**.
