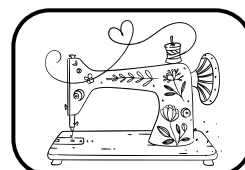


## BLOCK OF THE MONTH SETTING PATTERN "WAVES"

*This setting pattern is based on 12½ UN-finished blocks (12" finished). It works great with "sampler" quilt blocks - but would also be really pretty with 12 similar blocks as well!*  
*Fabric requirements are for the SETTING only - it does not include any fabric or tutorials for the 12 blocks.*

### FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

| <b>Light (Sea Foam Green)</b><br>-Block Borders<br>-Inner Borders | $\frac{2}{3}$ yard                                        |
| <b>Top / Bottom Fabrics (2)</b>                                   | $\frac{3}{8}$ yard of EACH                                |
| <b>Middle Fabrics (2)</b>                                         | $\frac{1}{2}$ yard EACH                                   |
| <b>Colorful Side Borders</b>                                      | Scraps, or 1 fat eighth for EACH color (10 for each side) |
| <b>Outer Border</b>                                               | $\frac{7}{8}$ yard                                        |
| <b>Binding</b>                                                    | $\frac{2}{3}$ yard                                        |
| <b>Backing</b>                                                    | $4\frac{3}{4}$ yard                                       |

## CUTTING DIRECTIONS:

### BLOCK & INNER BORDER FABRIC:

- From the Sea foam Green fabric:
  - Cut (14) 1½ inch strips.
    - Set 6 aside for *INNER BORDER*
    - Cut the remaining 8 strips into (24) 1½ x 12½ inch rectangles

### MULTI-COLORED SIDE BORDER:

- For EACH of the 10 colors, cut (2) 2¼ x 7½ inch rectangles

### OUTER BORDER:

- Cut (8) 3½ inch strips.

### BINDING:

- Cut 8 strips at your desired binding size

### MIDDLE FABRICS:

- From EACH of the Magenta & Apricot fabrics:
  - Cut (2) 6½ inch strips.
    - Sub-cut into:
      - (4) 6½ x 12½ inch rectangles

### TOP/ BOTTOM FABRICS:

- From EACH of the Teal Green Floral & Blue Teal Dot Fabrics:
  - Cut (1) 12½ strip
    - Sub-cut into:
      - (1) 12½ x 10½ inch rectangle
      - (1) 12½ x 8½ inch rectangle
      - (1) 12½ x 6½ inch rectangle
      - (1) 12½ x 4½ inch rectangle

## SEWING DIRECTIONS:

*Trim your blocks to 12 ½ inches.*

### LAYOUT:

- Decide on the pleasing way you would like your blocks to layout.
- *Hint 1:* you may want to take a quick picture of layout for future reference once you start sewing with the blocks - to make sure you get them back the way you would like them
- *Hint 2:* when deciding on the layout, look for blocks with the colored corner and try not to put matching corner with the "wave" color that will be on the top or bottom of the block - it will ruin the effect of the wave rectangles on the finished quilt

### GREEN TOP/BOTTOM BLOCK BORDERS:

- Sew a light green (1½ x 12½ inch rectangle) to the top and bottom of each block.
- Press toward the green. (*It doesn't actually matter which way you press, but it presses easier toward the green - less seams*).

### CREATE THE MIDDLE "WAVES":

- Choose which color order you want the waves to be on your quilt.
  - *Hint: check the corners on the blocks to make sure you don't have any that match the wave fabric!*
  - **NOTE - we will be working in COLUMNS, not rows, in this piecing!**

- Sew them between the blocks in the order that you chose.
  - *Hint: it helps to keep all the blocks laid out somewhere as you work so you don't get confused on the order of the blocks and the "wave" pieces!*

### **TOP AND BOTTOM WAVES:**

- Choose the colors you want on the top and bottom
  - You will need to pair up the 10½ and 4½ of each color so they make 14 inches; and also pair up the 8½ and 6½ of each color to make 14 inches.
    - EX: The 10½ inch Teal Floral needs to be paired with the 4½ inch Blue Dot piece in the same column.
  - Sew on the top and bottoms of your block columns

### **COMPLETE QUILT TOP:**

- Sew the columns together - just line up the top/bottom. *There are no seams to match up!*

### **ADD THE BORDERS:**

- Use the Sea foam Green 1½ inch strips that were set aside before for the INNER BORDER.
  - You will need to sew 2 together for each side all around.
  - Attach to the quilt top on the sides first, then the top and bottom.
- Make the multi-colored side borders.
  - Layout the side rectangles in a layout you like (I made my 2 sides match).
  - Sew the pieces together end to end and press any way you like.
  - Attach them to the sides only of the quilt top.
- For the OUTER BORDER.
  - Use the Dark Apricot fabric.
  - Sew 2 strips together for each side all around.
  - Attach to the quilt top, sides first, then top and bottom.

### **FINISHING:**

- Quilting: You will need (2) 2¾ yard cuts with a vertical seam to complete this top. It will give you a backing 80(ish) x 85½ inches.
- Binding: Cut (8) strips at your desired width, join, and bind.
