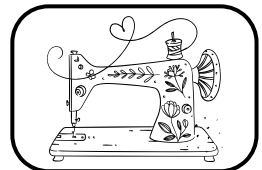


## BLOCK OF THE MONTH SETTING PATTERN "CORNERS"

*This setting pattern is based on 12½ UN-finished blocks (12" finished). This setting can be made with single-colored corners OR multi-colored corners. Single-colored corners adds a 3-dimensional effect - kind of looks like a checkerboard behind the blocks! Diagrams for both are included in the pattern. BOTH ways are very pretty!*

*Fabric requirements are for the SETTING only - it does not include any fabric or tutorials for the 12 blocks.*

### FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

| Light / Background<br>(includes inner border) | 1¼ yard                                                                                             |
| Colored Corners                               | <b>ONE Color:</b> ¾ yard<br>-OR-<br><b>Multi-Color:</b> ¼ yard EACH of <u>FOUR</u> different colors |
| Outer Border                                  | 1 yard                                                                                              |
| Binding                                       | ⅔ yard                                                                                              |
| Backing                                       | 3½ yard                                                                                             |

## CUTTING DIRECTIONS:

### LIGHT/BACKGROUND FABRIC:

- Cut (17) 2½ inch strips.
  - Set 7 strips aside for INNER BORDER.
  - Sub-cut the remaining strips into:
    - (24) 2½ x 6½ inch rectangles
    - (24) 2½ x 8½ inch rectangles

### OUTER BORDER:

- Cut (8) 4 inch strips.

### BINDING:

- Cut 8 strips of your chosen binding size.

### DARK, OR COLORED, FABRIC(S):

- For **ONE** color option:
  - Cut (10) 2½ inch strips.
    - Sub-cut into:
      - (24) 2½ x 6½ inch rectangles
      - (24) 2½ x 8½ inch rectangles
- For **MULTI** color (4 colors) option:
  - Cut (3) 2½ strips of EACH COLOR
    - Sub-cut into:
      - (6) 2½ x 6½ inch rectangles
      - (6) 2½ x 8½ inch rectangles

## SEWING DIRECTIONS:

*Trim all the blocks to 12½ inches.*

### BLOCK BORDERS (CORNERS):

- Choose which colors you want to wrap around which blocks. You will want to have the same color on each "corner" of the same block.
- Sew a LIGHT 2½ x 6½ inch rectangle to a DARK 2½ x 6½ inch rectangle, end-to-end. Make 24.
- Attach to the top and bottom of each block. Make sure to keep the SAME COLORS on each block!
  - *Hint: make sure to place the dark fabric on the LEFT on the TOP, and on the RIGHT on the BOTTOM of the blocks. Look at the diagram for a reference!*
- REPEAT with the 2½ x 8½ inch rectangles, but sew to the SIDES of the blocks - matching the colors.

### INNER BORDER:

- Sew (2) inner border strips together for each side of the quilt. Trim the length to match the length of your quilt. Attach to the sides.
- Sew the remaining strips together, cut the strip to the measurement across your quilt top. Repeat with the bottom border.

### OUTER BORDER:

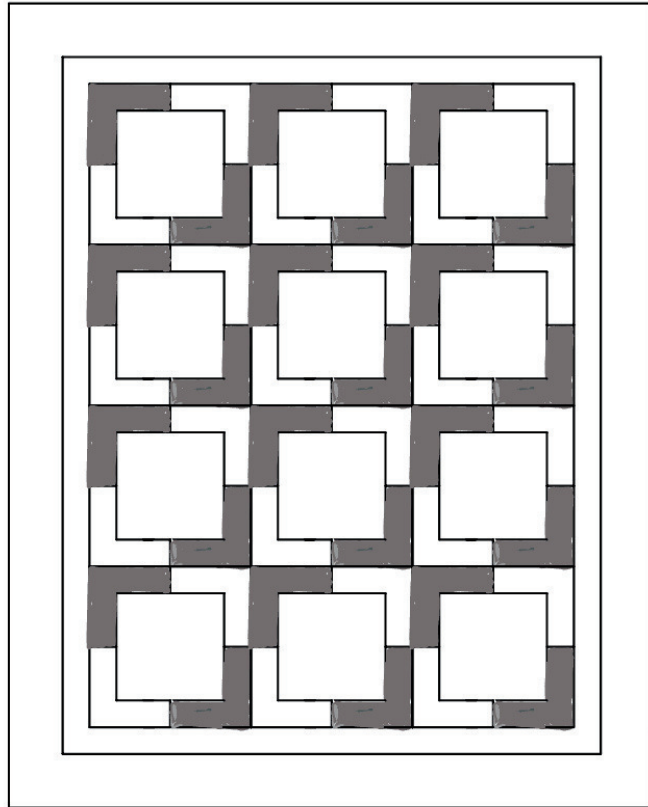
- Sew (2) inner border strips together for each side of the quilt. Trim the length to match the length of your quilt. Attach to the sides.
- Repeat for the top and bottom borders.

### FINISHING:

- Quilt: To complete the backing, you need (2) 1¾ yard cuts. Open and sew along the selvage edge. This will give you a measurement of 63 x 80(ish) inches.
- Binding: Cut (8) strips at your desired width, join, and bind.
