### Itinerary

#### Day 01 – 03 September, 2025: Nairobi

Arrive Nairobi – Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, (Optional VIP meet/greet and charged separately) as you are met off the plane and assisted to clear with Immigration/Customs & Health formalities. Thereafter, assisted with luggage and walked to international arrival lounge. Here, you will meet your hosts – Destination Africa dmc Ltd representatives. Receive a hearty ‘Nairobi’ Karibu ‘Welcome’ as you are directed to the vehicle/s for a one group onward transfer to the hotel. On arrival, assisted with check-in formalities. #### Day 02 – 04 September, 2025: Nairobi



Full day spent in Nairobi. Breakfast at the hotel. 7.30 am, picked up and depart for a full day tour that will include a Tour of Nairobi National Park till 10.30 am when you proceed to David Sheldrick elephant orphanage for an hour public viewing tour (11.00 am – Noon). Here, you will interact with the baby elephants and enjoy a lecture on the project conducted by one of the keepers. Thereafter, transfer to Java restaurant at Galleria Mall for lunch.



Thereafter, embark on an afternoon tour for visits to Karen Blixen Museum and of the film fame 'Out' of Africa and then head to Giraffe Center where you will get an opportunity to hand-feed the rare and endangered Rothschild giraffes. Should time permit, a visit to Kazuri Beads factory and enjoy shopping in some of the nearby curio shops that have some very unique souvenirs to take back home before your return to the hotel. Early evening, at 6.30 pm, take a short walk to 101 Villa for a home-hosted Dinner by Duncan (CEO/MD of Destination Africa dmc Ltd).

**Day 04 – 06 September, 2025: Amboseli National Park**

#### **Day 05 – 07 September, 2025: Samburu Game Reserve**



After an early breakfast, at 7.30 am, you will be transferred in lodge vehicle/s to the airstrip for a morning scheduled flight to Nairobi. On arrival, connect on another scheduled flight and fly to Samburu Game Reserve. On arrival, met by your safari driver guides and enjoy a short game drive to the camp. **PAYMENT POLICY - UPON CONFIRMATION OF THE TOUR**

- A deposit of 25% is required at the time of booking.
- A further 25% is required at 90 days prior to arrival
- And The balance is due 65 days before commencement of the arrangements
- If the reservation is made within 65 days of departure, the whole amount (100%) must be made at the time of confirmation.

**General Cancellation Policy:**

- 120-90 days prior to departure will be subject to a cancellation charge of 25% of the tour Cost.
- 90 – 75 days prior to departure will be subject to a cancellation charge of 50% of the tour cost
- 75 – 60 days prior to departure will be subject to a cancellation charge of 75% of the tour cost
- Cancellations received within 60 days of departure will be subject to forfeiture of the entire tour cost (100%).
