

The name of the month, January, is old. It seems to have roots in legend, added to the Roman calendar sometime, B.C., during the 600's. January 1, furthermore, seems to have been named the first day of the year by Rome in 153 B.C., prompted by some forgotten military defeat.

But whenever its origins, it's old. And as far as its name, its not a random collection of letters, but comes from the name of some pagan god: the Roman god, Janus, who was commonly pictured as having two faces—one looking back and the other, facing forward.

As January 2024 begins, many of us take time to look back at the stuff that made up last year: our successes and failures, and endurance and struggles in everyday life. And we do just the same in our lives as a church.

We remember those in this family we've lost through the year, and we continue to pray for those who are struggling with health, employment, and family dynamics. And we've seen how things change that we don't expect. We've suddenly seen wars causing mass suffering; we've had sickness suddenly strike the people we love; and there's weather that's dried up our pastures and crops, and always the threat of tornados and hailstorms.

There's ample evidence, looking back through the

year, that bad things can certainly come in our future.

But looking ahead, just like a farmer looks forward to planting, and just like a herdsman looks forward to calves coming soon, we look forward to life because of our Lord.

We look forward, together, with hope and relief because Jesus is with us now and forever.

We've heard His good word of forgiveness of sins. We've heard his great promise of raising the dead. We've seen children welcomed into His family, washed by the waters of Baptism. And there've been those who have joined us at the Lord's table for the very first time.

We've seen people who've given their talents and time to share Jesus' love: teaching our youth in Sunday School classes; and coming together to study the Bible; and serving the grieving at funeral lunches, and sharing their treasure to help folks in need.

And we know Jesus' call to be his disciples came with His promise to send us God's Spirit to lead us and guide us. And keeping this promise all through last year, Jesus will as we turn our face to the future.

January has two faces: one looking back and one looking forward. And for us, as God's people, we add one more face to this month: we add a face full of Hope that comes from our faith in Jesus, our Lord, and all He has promised.

vent Service of the season on Dec. 3. Thank you to all our choirs for providing music for the remainder of the Advent season & Christmas services. A special thank you goes out to our bell choirs and choir members who participated in the Ecumenical Choir Service on Dec. 10 along with ushers, clergy & ladies in the kitchen who served the reception.

The new year is fast approaching and choir rehearsals are scheduled to resume on Wed, Jan 3. The regular rehearsal times as follows:

As with any home, we have had maintenance issues crop up over the year that we did not expect. One of our **sound system speakers** in church stopped functioning well, and significant evidence of bats began to be seen. Replacing this speaker in the front, along with the same vintage speaker in the back of the church, totaled \$7479. **Bat proofing** our sanctuary totaled \$1284, and is so far successful. Your generous past and current donations have lowered the balance of each expense to \$3624.11 and \$934 respectively. Your gifts to defray these expenses will help us continue to care for this place, which serves as a base for our ministries.
