We will find, just as the light grows longer among us and the buds on our trees start showing green, "...that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor rulers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, 39nor height, nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord." (Romans 8:38-39)

We begin the season of Lent with Ash Wednesday worship, March 2, and will continue our worship on Wednesdays at 7:00 p.m. God bless you this season as we prepare to celebrate the death and resurrection of our Lord, Jesus Christ.


