I took a drive down Elon Road the other day. It wasn't because I was tired of being cooped up in the house. I wanted to see how fit the fields were for cultivation and how fieldwork was progressing. And I saw something encouraging:

Spring is still happening.

I saw emerald green conservation strips of seeding literally glowing next to fields of stubble; I saw a couple of absolutely huge honey wagons on their way to or from spreading their contents on our warming soil; and there was this pretty big grain drill, pulled by a pretty big tractor, making short work of a field around Waterville, probably drilling oats.

A lot of things in our lives have been put on hold in this current health emergency, but a lot of good things haven't been: Spring calves have hit the ground and are doing well; the ground is solid underfoot for fieldwork; and even in this time of social distancing, we are finding ways to still keep connected in our personal lives and even in our church.

Like many of you who have been using the internet and social media to keep connected with family and friends, our Confirmation youth at St. John's have been keeping connected through Zoom meet-

ings on the internet and through postings on Facebook. Our Education Ministry volunteers are offering Zoom Sunday School and have been preparing weekly Sunday School lessons for pick up at our parking lot door, and our radio ministry, a longstanding ministry of St. John's, continues to broadcast a worship service each Sunday.

Volunteers from our church and community have been working together to provide anthems for our worship and background voices for our hymns. James Bieber and Lindsey Lund have provided accompaniment for our songs, and solo and duet work on our keyboards. And we have had the honor of having Fr. Mark Osterhaus from St. Patrick Church, Waukon, and Pr. Grant Vandervelden from the First Presbyterian Church, Waukon, join us for worship and share a few words with our radio worshippers.

With these good things happening, there are still many challenges that you and I are currently facing in our ministries:

I cannot visit our members yet in their homes, hospitals, or care facilities. Funerals are currently limited to small, graveside services, and I have limited access to be with grieving families. Sunday School, Confirmation, and first communion instruction are on hold until we can worship together, again. And although we were able to broadcast Easter worship, the biggest day in our life of faith, we were not able to celebrate it together, and we won't be gathering for worship until it's once again deemed safe.

These are challenging times. But please know

that we are safe in Jesus' hands and that our future, even though we don't know what it will hold in the short term, is secure. We have a Lord, after all, who rose from the dead after he was killed, and we have a God who can turn bad things like the cross on their heads, and bring life out of death.

We thank God for this good news of Easter, the new life of Spring sprouting around us, and the ways we continue to connect with Jesus and each other. May the Holy Spirit continue to give us faith, hope, and patience until that time when we can gather together again.
