As the month of October arrives, a lot of good things have already slipped back into gear at St. John's Lutheran.

Sunday School has begun. Our Lutheran Youth Organization has started planning for our youth to attend the National Youth Gathering next year in Minneapolis. And our Wednesday night ministries of music and education have started their work.

Our Confirmation youth are now meeting on Wednesdays. In keeping with their parents' promise to place in their hands the Holy Scriptures, we'll be helping them do that by teaching the Bible in class throughout the year.

The reason we do this is simple. When a person is baptized here in church, those of us there hear this question that's directed to us: "People of God, do promise to support this person and pray for them in their new life in Christ? If so, please say 'I do.""

Each of us individually and collectively as a church say and have said, "I do."

After parents have promised to do things like teach their kids the Lord's Prayer, the Creed,

and the Ten Commandments, and place in their hands the Holy Scriptures, we promise to support their children and them. And we offer our Sunday School and Confirmation ministries as ways to keep our promise.

On October 31, Reformation Sunday, some of our Confirmation youth will get up in front of us at worship and say in public what they believe. They'll be asked questions, just like their parents were when they had these children baptized:

"Do you believe in God the Father?" "Do you believe in God, the Son?" "Do you believe in God, the Holy Spirit?"

And at this Confirmation Service, they'll all be prepared to answer with us: "I believe in God the Father, Almighty, creator of heaven and earth. I believe in Jesus Christ, God's only Son, our Lord...."

Our ministries, here, of worship, education, and service, have prepared them, their parents, and us to confess our faith together. We'll do it at a special second service on that day, at 10:45 A.M., Reformation Day, where we join many other churches celebrating the Good News of Jesus, that's always reforming His church and keeping us together in the faith.
