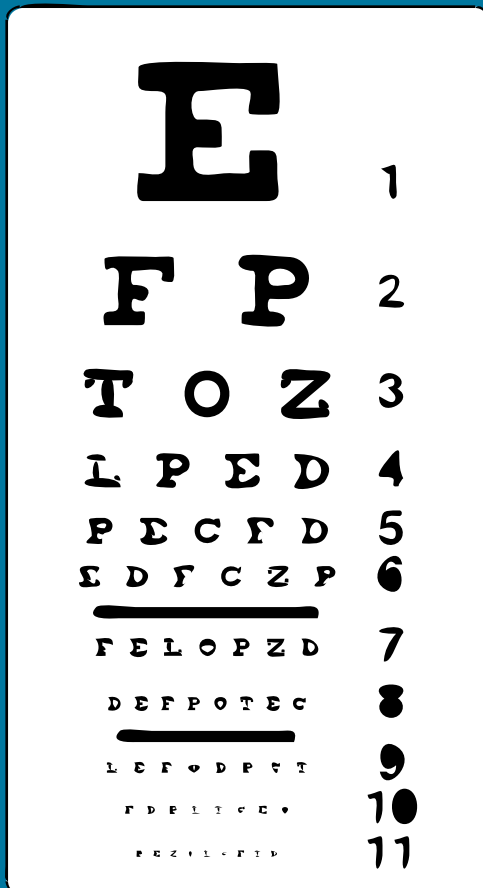


What we recommend:

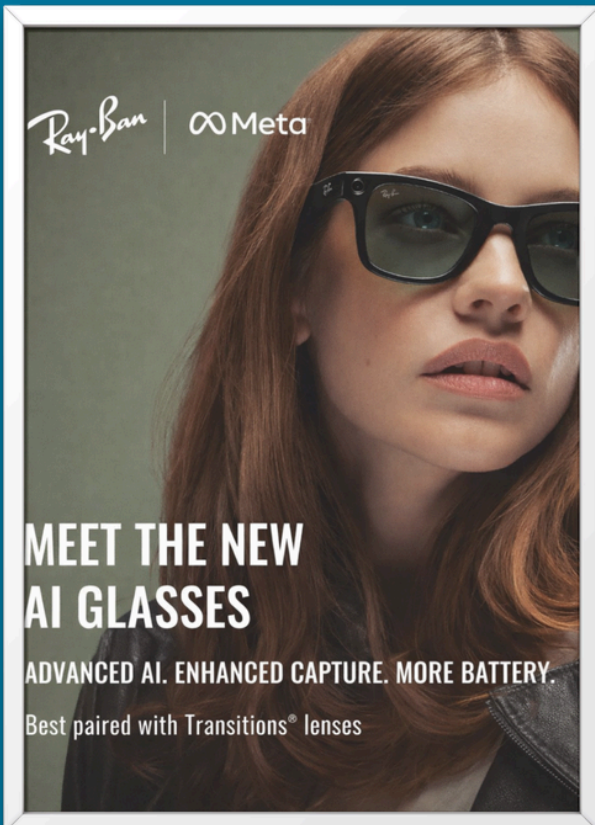
