To further our mission of supporting the community, the TBCJ Scholarship Program was established to reward and assist individuals who are pursuing higher education. We are pleased to announce the availability of two (2) scholarships for each academic year, each valued at \$1,000.

These scholarships are open to qualified high school seniors who meet the following criteria:

## **Eligibility Requirements:**

- Residency: Applicants must be residents of one of the following counties in Florida: Duval and Clay.
- Education: Applicants must be graduating high school seniors planning to attend an accredited University, College, Trade/Vocational School, or Technical College in the Fall for which the application is submitted.
- Course of Study: Scholarships can be used for Associate or Bachelor's degree programs or legitimate trade/vocational/technical training programs.

## How to Apply:

- **Application Deadline**: 31 May of each year
- Required Documents:
  - o Completed scholarship application form
  - Official high school transcript
  - One letter of recommendation by a high school faculty member (mentor, counselor, clergyman, etc.)
  - o A personal essay describing your educational goals and how this scholarship will help you achieve them.
