## Bio

Oscar Philly delivers humor, heart, and impossible breath control, blurring the lines between old-school hip-hop grit and modern R&B smoothness. A commanding performer with a relaxed, magnetic stage presence, he's been described as "masterful and engaging," with a charm that draws in audiences as easily as his quick-witted lyricism does. His work is built on connection; the kind of music that makes strangers feel like a roomful of friends.

A lifelong musician, by twelve, he was already singing and rapping along to his favorite records, and at thirteen, a friend's offhand comment that he had "a great voice for hip-hop" lit a fire that's burned ever since. Today, he's a multi-instrumentalist and producer whose roots in instrumental study inform his songwriting and sonic imagination. His tracks move seamlessly between rhythmic precision and melodic flow, often threading live textures through digital production to build something that feels both nostalgic and forward-looking.

Originally from Colorado, Oscar made his name performing across the state with acts like Chewy & Bach and Retro Spects & Oscar Philly, releasing multiple projects and playing venues ranging from small mountain-town bars to sold-out shows at The Fox Theater in Boulder. His work with Chewy & Bach helped evolve the group's sound from a DJ-guitar duo to a seven-piece ensemble, while his collaborations with Retro Spects yielded a self-produced EP, full-length mixtape, and a string of singles that earned him somewhat of a following in Colorado's independent hip-hop and crossover scenes.

Now based in Portland, Oregon, Oscar is pursuing a degree in Sonic Arts & Music Production at Portland State University, with a new EP slated for release in spring 2026. The project blends his love of 90s hip-hop and R&B with more modern textures, touching on themes of connection, growth, and self-reflection. For Oscar, music is both expression and empathy; a way to translate lived experience into shared energy. "If one person feels less alone because of it," he says, "then I've done my job."
