## Playing Card Progressive Raffle (AKA Jack of Spades Raffle) House Rules

Raffle License #C32460 Effective Date: 3/21/2025

- 1) A standard deck of playing cards including jokers will be used. Playing cards will be verified to ensure all cards are present.
- 2) Each card will be placed in a security envelope and sealed. Envelopes will be signed across the seal by four chairpersons, shuffled, consecutively numbered beginning with 1 through 54, then placed in a locked display cabinet.
- 3) The jackpot prize card is the Jack of Spades. The jackpot prize card must be selected to win the jackpot.
- 4) The jackpot prize will be 60% of total raffle sales minus any consolation prizes paid.
- 5) Raffle tickets will be sold for \$5.00 each, and new raffle tickets must be purchased for each drawing date. No discounts are allowed on raffle tickets for any reason including multiple ticket purchases.
- 6) Raffle ticket purchasers must be at least 18 years old.
- 7) Raffle chairpersons, Macomb Foster Closet board members, and Roger's Roost owners, investors, and staff--and the immediate household members or all those listed--are not eligible to purchase raffle tickets, receive raffle tickets as gifts, or share in any prize awarded from the raffle.
- 8) Only raffle chairpersons may manage the raffle.
- 9) Raffle ticket purchasers may write their selected envelope number on the ticket stub in the event they are not present at the drawing.
- 10) Drawings will be conducted every Wednesday, at 8:00pm, at Roger's Roost (33626 Schoenherr Road, Sterling Heights, MI 48312) beginning April 2, 2025 and April 15, 2026. Exceptions: No drawing on November 26, 2025, December 24, 2025, or December 31, 2025.
- 11) One ticket stub will be drawn on each drawing date, and the winning ticket purchaser will select an envelope number from the display case.
  - a. If the winning ticket purchaser is present and an envelope number is written on the ticket stub and is available, then the selected envelope will be opened for the winning ticket purchaser.
  - b. If the winning ticket purchaser is present and did not write an envelope number on the ticket stub, or if the envelope number is no longer available, then the ticket purchaser may select an available envelope number from the display case and will be opened for the winning ticket purchaser.
  - c. If the winning ticket purchaser is not present and an envelope number is written on the ticket stub, then the selected envelope will be opened for the winning ticket purchaser.
  - d. If the winning ticket purchaser is not present and did not write an envelope number on the ticket stub, or if the envelope number is no longer available, then the lowest numbered envelope remaining in the case will be opened for the winning ticket purchaser.
  - e. The winning ticket stub will be attached to the Progressive Raffle Accountability form for that drawing date.
- 12) If the selected envelope contains the jackpot prize card, then the winning ticket purchaser will receive the jackpot prize. All jackpot prizes must be paid by check. All ticket stubs from the current drawing will be destroyed, except the winning ticket stub. If dates are remaining under the license, then a new playing card progressive raffle may begin on the next licensed date.
- 13) If the selected envelope does not contain the jackpot prize card, then the playing card that is revealed will be placed face up in the display case in its original location among the numbered envelopes. The jackpot prize will be carried forward, all ticket stubs from the current drawing will be destroyed, except the winning ticket stub, and ticket sales will begin for the next drawing.
- 14) Consolation prizes will be paid as follows (maximum of one consolation prize per drawing):

a. Ticket stub drawn =

\$10 Roger's Roost gift card

b. Non-jackpot spade 2-10 card =

\$25 Roger's Roost gift card

c. Non-jackpot spade ace and face cards =

\$100 Roger's Roost gift card

- d. \*\*\*No consolation prizes will be paid on the last drawing date or if jack of spades card is drawn.\*\*\*
- 15) In the event of an emergency or severe weather that prevents a scheduled drawing from taking place, the drawing will be held on the next licensed date at the scheduled time and location.
- 16) A refund will be available for any raffle ticket that is sold but the ticket stub is turned in too late to be entered into the drawing.
- 17) On the last drawing date, ticket stubs will be drawn and envelopes selected until the jackpot prize is won.
- 18) Prizes must be claimed within 60 days of the drawing date. A diligent effort will be made to contact all prize winners. Any unclaimed prizes will be donated to another nonprofit organization serving children in foster care upon written approval from the Charitable Gaming Division.
