Eligibility

Must live in Macomb County, Children MUST have active Medicaid, and Any child from birth to age 21

How It Works

Instead of calling the police or going to your local emergency department, call the Macomb County Children's Mobile Crisis Unit. We will come to your home or community setting, where the crisis is occurring.

Within 1 hour of the initial phone call, a master's level therapist, and a parent support partner will arrive to assist in resolving the situation.

Once the crisis has been resolved, the team will ensure that you have a crisis plan in place and assist with either referring you for ongoing services or follow up with your assigned clinician by the next business day.

Examples Prompting a Call

Suicidal or homicidal thoughts Physical aggression Uncontrolled tantrums Anything a parent/guardian feels is a crisis
