We are delighted to report that March broke the cycle. The last day of January and February saw us have equipment failure on two different units. The last day of March only produced a clogged toilet for a problem.

We are delighted to share that an anonymous donor has provided the funds for us to purchase a new commercial freezer. We expect to take delivery shortly. This will not only increase our storage capacity but also allow us to take off line two very old inefficient units.

Attendance in March returned to previous levels. Though there was a slight falling off in numbers attending in January and February, March saw 365 families visit which is very close to last year's attendance of 383. We added 20 new families in March.

We are making plans to offer a special meal for the week prior to Easter and sign-ups are currently proceeding.

Confirmation Classes will be held on the fourth Sunday of every month, at 6:30 pm, from September – May.


Our next Confirmation class will be on Sunday, May 25th at 6:30 pm in Fellowship Hall. Pizza will be provided. Students should complete their homework before class!

VBS Volunteer Information

We can't have VBS without our volunteers! We need a lot of help to run each session.

Group Leaders are responsible for taking their group of kids (broken down by age group) from station to station. Group Leaders are with the same group of kids all day. The different age groups are Pre-K & Kindergarten, 1st-3rd Grade, and 4th-6th Grade. We need two adults with each group.

Station Leaders are responsible for running their stations: Games, Snack, Lesson, Music, Craft, and Science. Station Leaders are provided with a book with the lessons, crafts, etc. explained. Most even have a script, so it's easy to teach! Only one adult is needed to teach each station, though the more, the merrier!

Youth Volunteers entering 7th grade and up are welcome to join us as a helping hand! They can help with groups or stations.

ALL VOLUNTEERS must complete St. John's Mandatory Volunteer Training, and ALL ADULT **VOLUNTEERS** must have completed their Pennsylvania Child Abuse Clearance as well as their Pennsylvania Background Check. Links are on the VBS page on our website.


