

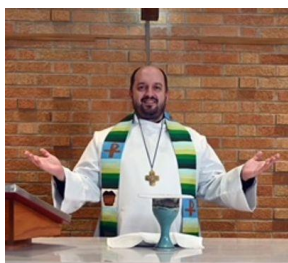

A Letter from Pastor Bo

November 2024 – The Prequel – The House the Saints Built

Last November, we ended Year A's Old Testament Readings with Deborah and the period of the Judges. This June, Year B's readings began with Samuel and Saul and David. (The Lectionary gives us the option of using Summer and Fall to read through the Old Testament chronologically, which is what we've been doing. We have one more, Year C, which focuses on the prophets.)

In November, we go back to the period of Judges again, with the story of Ruth. Maybe it's fitting to travel back to the beginning of David's line at the time when we ourselves look back to the saints who came before us who are still with us. And then to the birth of Samuel. And then on Christ the King Sunday, David's celebration of this royal house God has promised and fulfilled.

November 3rd – All Saints. The Hungry Refugee. The saint who prepared the way for King David is a most unlikely saint – a poor pagan widow, Ruth, an asylum seeker from Moab, an enemy country. How she expressed her faith was by clinging to an Israelite widow (Naomi) who thought her own life was over. It would have been, but this companionship blossomed forth new life, not just for the two women, but for the whole world.

November 10th – A Conspiracy of Hope. It's not just laughs and giggles that made Ruth and Naomi so important. It was shrewd and strategic choices they made to survive and prosper. This week contains tips on how to win a good man and become the great-grandmother of a king. Actually, do not try this at home.

November 17th – When Your Back's Against the Wall. A new story, but also centering a woman. Hannah, one of two wives of Elkanah, is trapped in life. There is no good ending to her story. She is finished and all alone, unless God comes to her rescue. She weeps bitterly to God, and God comes through.

November 24th – Christ the King Sunday. The Last Words of David. Looking at what God has fulfilled, David claims that God's kingdom in the world brings light and joy and prosperity, as well as judgment for the wicked. Something to be thinking of around the Thanksgiving table, am I right?

We thank Church of the Advent for their monetary donation. Also, we thank Redeemer Lutheran for donating three more cases of the prepacked meals. And, thanks to Hatboro Chamber of Commerce as the 3rd Friday of the month Cruise Night season of collecting food items ended on September 20.

Cupboard attendance for September 2024 exceeded that of September 2023 by 48 families. In completing statistics for one of our donor organizations, we calculated that 177 new families have signed up since the first of January.

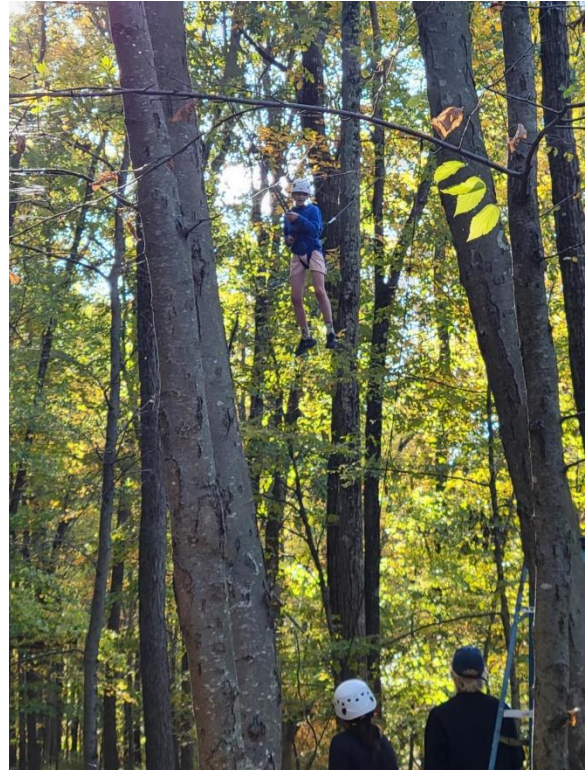
Pet Blessing

Nursery

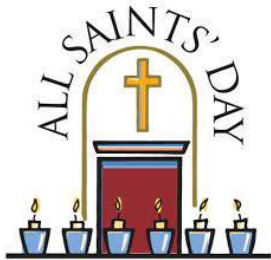
