This November will straddle that thin veil between heaven and earth. Or will maybe be like that ladder Jacob saw between heaven and earth with angels going up and down it. Our hope for something better will fuel our actions in making earth more like heaven.

November 2nd – The Righteous Will Live By Faith. This All Saints Day, we grapple with sadness and hope. Like Habakkuk, we wonder why bad things happen. But we look with expectation, knowing that no one will be lost, and that one day we will be reunited with or loved ones. Zacchaeus shows us what it looks like to live by faith.

The Community Outreach Ministries would like to thank the Congregation for again supporting our August Backpack and School Supplies collection and our September Fall Harvest for the St. John's Community Cupboard.

We are now gearing up for our Thanksgiving and Christmas projects.

Grace Lutheran is our first November project. We will be collecting both food and gift cards. Look for information in the Weekly Announcements.

Next is the Hatboro Holiday Parade. St. John's plays an important role in this, as we are at the gathering place for many different organizations participating in the Parade. We supply hot dogs, coffee, hot chocolate, water, and snacks, as well as warm place to hang out and the extremely important restrooms. We will have a signup sheet on the bulletin board for anyone who would like to help or donate cookies and snacks.

Our final project is the Giving Tree. This will be set up in the Narthex with cards on it with items, gift cards, etc. that will be shared with a Women's Place, The Breathing Room, and Valley Youth House in Warminster.

Thank you again for your continued support and if you are interested in joining our Committee we will be having a meeting sometime in January. We always welcome new members and new ideas!

Community Outreach Ministries

Food Pantry Report

September brought an increase in client visits. We served 414 families during the month and registered 25 new families.

We continue to restock using the MAHN grant in addition to the generous donations received from our partner churches as well as Riverside Church in Horsham who completed a food drive that was split between Willow Grove Baptist and our cupboard. The Women's Ministry of St. John's also conducted a food drive during September that helped stock our shelves with much needed items. The Grocery Outlet food drive is scheduled for October 11 and 12 from 10:00 AM until 2:00 PM. The food pantry team leaders and volunteers will be greeting the shoppers and provide a list of most needed items for the pantry. We will have leaders at the exit door to collect the donations from the shoppers and bring them back to the pantry.

We received several large cash donations from private donors, our partner churches, as well as the Hatboro Rotary. We are truly blessed to receive these unexpected but most welcome donations.

We have been blessed to add a new driver to our list of volunteers. He came in to meet with us on Tuesday and we put him right to work on Wednesday picking up Garden of Health donations with CJ.

We continue to search for a substitute team leader. We are confident that God will provide the right person in His time.

As always we are grateful for our volunteers and all of the organizations that support us in our efforts to food to those most in need.

Youth Group is held on the third Saturday of every month at 6:30 pm, from September – May.


This month's event will be a Friendsgiving dinner in Fellowship Hall on Saturday, November 15th. Bring a side or dessert to share!


